Separate and sealed proposals for "Clearfield County Bridge Maintenance - Scour Protection" will be received by the Clearfield County Commissioners, 212 E. Locust Street, Suite 112, Clearfield, PA 16830, until 10:00 A.M. prevailing local time on Tuesday, December 2, 2025, when the sealed proposals received will be publicly opened and read aloud. PennDOT prequalification is required. The project includes excavation and placement of rip-rap scour protection for four selected county bridges.

A certified check or bid bond payable to or naming as obligee the Clearfield County Commissioners in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid must be deposited with the proposal as a guarantee that in case the contract is awarded the successful bidder will execute the contract and furnish all bonds as may be required. Proposals must be sealed in an envelope and marked "Clearfield County Bridge Maintenance - Scour Protection", bear the name and address of the bidder, and be addressed to:

No bidder may withdraw his or her bid within sixty (60) days after the actual opening thereof.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid to employees on this project in accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Labor and Industry, Prevailing Minimum Wage Predetermination decision.

The contract will expire on June 30, 2026. It is anticipated that notice-to-proceed will be issued on or about December 5, 2025.
