

NOTICE

The following publicly owned treatment works (POTW) has requested approval of a modification to its pretreatment program. The proposed modification would discontinue the implementation of the POTW's pretreatment program on the basis that the POTW no longer meets the criteria of 40 C.F.R. 403.8(a). If the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approves this request, the POTW can continue to operate a program under local law; however, it would not be an EPA-approved pretreatment program under the General Pretreatment Regulations (40 C.F.R. Part 403). The POTW would remain responsible for complying with all requirements of its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

How to Provide Comments or Request a Hearing

Any person may provide comments or request a public hearing on the request for approval of the proposed modifications within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice to the above email or mailing address. Any request for a public hearing shall indicate the interest of the person filing such request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. If no substantive comments on the request for approval are received by the end of this comment period, the proposed modifications referenced above will be approved without changes and without further public notice. In such event, this notice constitutes the "notice of approval or disapproval". Any person who submitted comments, participated in the public hearing, if held, or requests to receive notice of approval or disapproval of the modifications by emailing or writing to the above email or mailing address will be notified of any approval or disapproval.
