Growing with our Customers: Cargill's sunflower oil supply chain supports Europe's foodservice

For foodservice customers, cooking oil is more than an ingredient; it is a critical part of daily operations. Restaurants depend on frying oils that deliver consistent performance and reliable supply, helping them maintain quality and efficiency at scale.

Europe's foodservice sector consumes more than 3 million tons of sunflower oil each year, making it the preferred edible oil in professional kitchens across the region. As QSRs continue to grow, so does the need for supply partners like Cargill with the scale, expertise, and resilience to reliably meet rising demand and navigate an increasingly complex market.

"Our supply chain connects every stage, from sourcing, crushing, refining and bottling into one integrated system," says David Isaacson, senior director for Foodservice and Retail at Cargill. "Designed to handle complexity, it delivers the reliability our customers rely on."



A resilient supply chain built for growth

Sunflower seeds sourced from multiple growing regions in Europe, including Romania, Bulgaria and France, move through an integrated network of crushing, refining, and bottling operations before reaching customers across Western Europe.

At the heart of that network is Cargill's Multiseed Crush & Refinery in Amsterdam,



dam, where sunflower seeds are processed to meet strict food safety and quality stan-

dards.

From Amsterdam, oil continues to Izegem, Belgium. Home to Europe's largest edible oil bottling facility and a strategic hub serving foodservice customers across Western Europe, including major brands such as McDonald's, KFC, Burger King and Five Guys, we've invested €21 million to transform the site.

Around 60% of the facility has been upgraded, nearly doubling production capacity while introducing advanced automation and digital technologies that improve efficiency, flexibility and supply reliability.

The expansion includes two dedicated production lines, helping the site respond faster to customer needs while supporting higher volumes across the region. The investment reflects Cargill's commitment to growing alongside customers and ensuring sufficient capacity to meet increasing foodservice demand across Europe.

"Automation and innovation are driving the flexibility and reliability our customers count on," says Alba Llorens, bottling plant manager in Izegem.

From the sunflower fields across Europe, through our integrated supply chain, our connected approach helps customers navigate market volatility while ensuring access to high-quality sunflower oil every day.

Hamburger Stew

Prep Time: 20 minutes

Cook Time: 65 minutes

Yield: 16 servings
(4 quarts)

Ingredients

2 pounds ground beef

2 medium onions, chopped

4 cans (14 ½ ounces each) stewed tomatoes, undrained

8 medium carrots, thinly sliced

4 celery ribs, thinly sliced



2 medium potatoes, peeled and cubed

2 cups water

½ cup uncooked long grain rice

3 teaspoons salt

1 teaspoon pepper

1. In a Dutch oven, cook beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink, breaking it into crumbles; drain. Add the tomatoes, carrots, celery, potatoes, water, rice, salt and pepper; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer 30 minutes or until vegetables and rice are tender.
2. Uncover; simmer 20-30 minutes longer or until thickened to desired consistency.
