Here are some more fun facts about coffee:

- **Discovery:** Coffee was first discovered in Ethiopia, possibly by a goat herder named Kaldi around 750 AD.
- **Coffee is a fruit:** Coffee beans are actually the seeds of the coffee cherry, a fruit that grows on coffee trees.
- **Caffeine and Roasts:** Darker roasts have less caffeine than lighter roasts because the roasting process burns off some of the caffeine.
- **Global Commodity:** Coffee is the second most traded commodity on earth.
- **Worldwide Consumption:** The world consumes about 2.25 billion cups of coffee daily according to CAFELY.
- **Finland's Coffee Culture:** Finns drink more coffee per capita than any other nation.
- **A World of Coffee:** There are 129 different species of coffee trees, but only two are commercially produced: Arabica and Robusta.
- **Decaf isn't Caffeine-Free:** Decaffeinated coffee still contains a small amount of caffeine.
- **Unique Coffee Production:** Kopi Luwak, the world's most expensive coffee, involves civet cats eating coffee cherries and excreting the beans.
- **Coffee's Impact:** Coffee consumption is linked to various potential health benefits, including a reduced risk of cardiovascular disease.
