



## **Blount County Schools Reopening Schedule 2020-2021**

Traditional learners grades 1-12 will continue the year in a hybrid schedule which will incorporate in-person learning and virtual learning for five days of instruction weekly. Students will attend school in their alphabetical cohort group. Kindergarten stagger start will continue as previously communicated from August 3-August 14, 2020. Kindergarten students should attend starting Monday, August 17, 2020 with the alphabetical cohort indicated below:

Students with last names A-K will have the opportunity to pick up meals on Tuesday evening, August 11, 2020 and Monday evening, August 17, 2020 from 5-6 PM at their school for up to two breakfasts and two lunches for each child.
