

Queen of Swing & Jazz Coming To Brenham's Barnhill Center

The internationally acclaimed entertainer, Gunhild Carling, will return to The Barnhill Center at Historic Simon Theatre (TBC) on Saturday, October 25th at 7pm.

This is the last show in the retro series celebrating the 100th birthday of the Simon Theatre. Gunhild Carling is known as the Queen of Swing, Jazz and Vaudeville.

"This amazing star is the epitome of joy as a dazzling singer, dancer, juggler, and multi-instrumental genius," said Sharon Brass, TBC producer. "In 2023 she thrilled our audience so much that we got multiple requests to bring her back."

"Part musical extravaganza, part Vaudevillian spectacle, this live performance is guaranteed to be one of the most feel-good, toe-tapping, exhilarating shows you'll ever see!"

With New Orleans Jazz and Big Band Swing as her foundation, Carling's style takes you back to the era of Louis Armstrong and Billie Holiday. Some of her vintage songs are *Minnie the Moocher*, *Sweet Georgia Brown*, *All of Me*, *It Had to Be You* – all within a larger repertoire of old favorites.

Carling plays over 10 instruments in a single show, and three trumpets at the same time. She is often featured with big bands, symphony orchestras, chamber orchestras, and as a diva vocalist with Postmodern Jukebox. She has over 70 million online followers.

She is a TV celebrity in Sweden, starring in *Allsang Pa Skansen*, *Let's Dance* (Dancing With The Stars, Sweden), *Fangarna pa Fortet* (Fear Factory), *Sa Skall Det Lata* (Songwriter's Board), *America's Got Talent*, and *ABC News*.

In 2014 she performed at the Royal Palace in Stockholm with her "Carling Big Band" for the celebration of King Carl XVI Gustaf's *Ruby Jubilee*. She returned to the Palace in 2016 to perform at the King's 70th birthday celebration.

In total, Carling has released eleven albums starting in 1985 with her debut, "I've Lost My Heart In Dixieland." Some albums were recorded with orchestras and some with her Big Band.

From 2006 – 2016 Carling managed and starred in the annual *Stockamollan Swing & Jazz Festival* in her hometown Stockamollan, with artists from all over the world.

Carling has won many accolades and awards, mostly in Europe.
