More Q1 wins than 3 ➡Tied with 4
Does it come down to who beat the most good teams? If so we have the same or more
Q1 wins than 7 of those 16 teams.
More wins against the field than 10
⇒Tied with 2
Teams that go to the NCAAT should have a record of competing well against the rest of
the teams in the field. Only 4 of those 16 teams have more wins against the field than
we do.
More Q1 & Q2 combined wins than 6
⇒Tied with 4
Again, if it's about winning the most games against the best teams than this should
speak for itself. Only 6 of those 16 teams have more Q1/Q2 wins than us.
Made it further in our conference tournament than 12
Not sure how much weight this carries but we made it to the championship game in
one of the best leagues in the country. Only 4 of those 16 other teams made it to the
championship like us and it feels as if we're punished for when our tournament takes place.
Better record in last 10 games than 13
⇒Tied with 3 There has to be some level of who is playing their best basketball at the right time.
There is not a single team with a better record in their last 10 games than us. There's
actually 13 teams with a worse record over those last 10 games than us. We are
playing our best basketball right when you want to be. If you want the best games with
the best teams then you need the teams playing the best when it means the most.
 Fewer Q3/Q4 games than 4 ➡Tied with 3
If it's about strength of schedule and playing as few "bad teams" as possible than we
have a case for that. Only 9 of the 16 teams played fewer Q3/Q4 games than us. If our
weak non conference schedule is what is being held against us then you should have to hold it against these 7 teams just as much.

More total wins (after removing DCC) than 8...

At then end of the day our record, resume, and strength of conference screams that we belong in the NCAAT. Only 6 of those 16 teams have more wins than us after removing DCC and 2 more are tied with us.

 Our 8 Game Losing Streak was more difficult than 10 of the 16's teams handed 8 games when looking at their average NET rankings...

The most difficult part of our season was our losing streak, both for how hard it was to overcome and how challenging the teams we were playing were. 10 of the 16 teams never had an 8 game stretch throughout their entire season with as challenging of opponents. Not to mention that 8 of those 16 teams 8 hardest game average wasn't even within 30 points from how difficult ours was (ours was 40.1).

 Our win streaks were not only impressive but against tougher competition than the best win streaks of 13 of the 16 teams...

We understand that our losing streak is the biggest red flag on our resume. But if our losing streak is to be weighed so highly then our win streak must be held in the same regards. There is only 2 of the 16 teams that had a win streak at any point in the season where the teams they beat in that streak had a better average NET Ranking than the teams we beat in our final win streak. Not only that but, similarly to the average NET rankings of some of these teams losing streaks compared to ours, the level of competition faced isn't relatively close for some of our competitors. 11 of those 16 teams had their worst losing streak opponent's average NET rankings 30 points worse than ours, some of them even being as high at 100 to 150 points worse!
