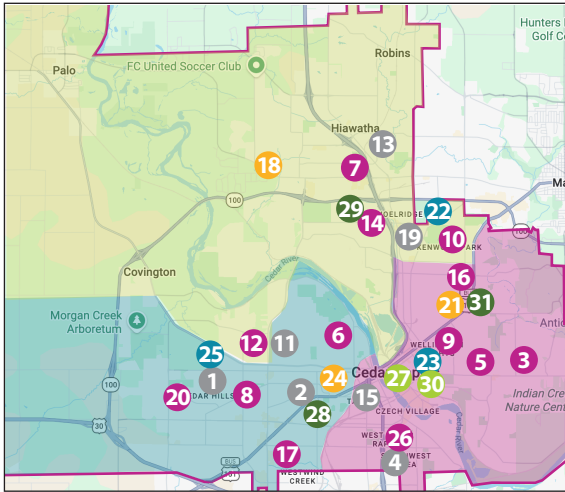


PROPOSED NEW HIGH SCHOOL BOUNDARIES FOR THE CEDAR RAPIDS SCHOOL DISTRICT

Proposed changes to attendance boundaries in the Cedar Rapids district would create a true feeder pattern — meaning students who begin together in kindergarten would remain at the same school through 12th grade — and could balance enrollment across schools.



The first attendance boundary proposal keeps high school boundaries the same as they are today, which means fewer students overall would be impacted under this model. However, this proposal creates an imbalance of elementary and middle school enrollment with buildings projected to be at between 50 to 95 percent capacity.
