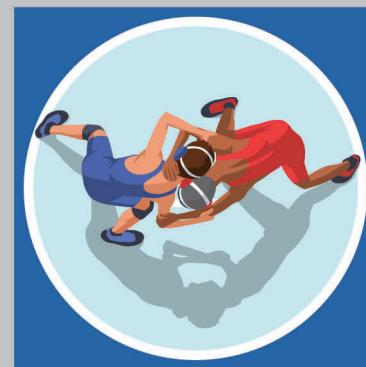

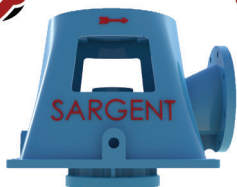

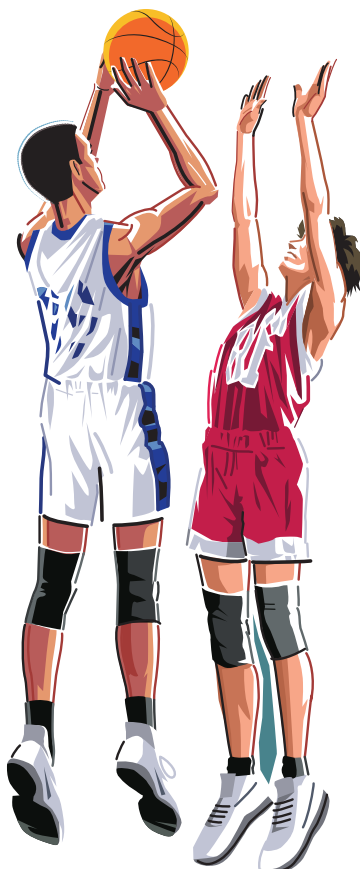

The girls team will also add five talented freshmen in Samantha Vinchattle, Krystal Fickenscher, Madi Hays, Jerzey Ramirez and Taelynn Myers.
The majority of our wrestlers, both boys and girls, spent the offseason working on improving their strength in the weight room and getting mat time through different camps and wrestling opportunities.
If we can stay healthy and improve throughout the season we should field a young but competitive class D wrestling team during the '25-'26 season with multiple wrestlers who are full of potential.
In recent years we have had two state champions--Jacob Fox at 126 in 2022 and Taaron Lavicky at 165 in 2024.
The top boys teams in the FKC this year should be Loomis, Amherst, Elm Creek, Wilcox-Hildreth and Pleasanton.

Impactful Newcomers: Freshmen- Brinley Pohl, Ella Warburton and McKinley Segelke all have middle school state experience and will look to make an impact right away.
Sophomore: Marlie Petersen missed last season due to injury but will look to contribute in a big way this year.
Outlook: Our team goal this year is to repeat as SWC champions, though we know we need to reload quickly after losing over half of last year's dominant team to graduation. Underclassmen will need to acclimate to the speed of high school wrestling and contribute to the varsity lineup if we hope to achieve our goal. We will continue to field a quality wrestler at every weight class which will keep us competitive in duals, but our lack of experienced seniors may show especially early in the season until the sophomore and junior leaders begin to find their footing. Several of the girls compete in spring wrestling, and we took a crew to Gunnison, Colorado for the Western Colorado dual team camp and we competed very well. We will see how fast they develop, but this is the most experienced group of freshmen I have ever had so I am excited to see what they can do this year! 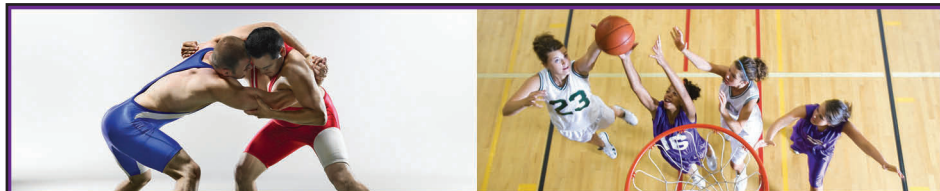

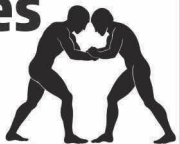
