



Total Solar Eclipse Aug 21, 2017

**Public / Private Parking Sites
Spaces will Fill Fast**

Lincoln City is excited to welcome large numbers of guests during the weekend leading up to the Monday solar eclipse. We hope you find your stay a safe and happy one.

You should have good viewing of the eclipse from most locations since the sun will be high in the sky during the the entire 2 hour eclipse.

Please note that our street grid is divided north from south at the D River, and east from west by Hwy 101, with a few exceptions.

The historic names of the areas that make up Lincoln City are listed on the left of the map for even more locational information.

- Plan to walk whenever possible
- Watch from where you are staying, or nearby, if you can
- Avoid blocking roads for other traffic/emergency vehicles
- Avoid left turns onto or off of Hwy 101 except at signaled intersections, and be patient
- Viewing will be to the east, high in the sky.
- Make sure to use eclipse glasses when looking at the sun
- Keep a close eye on small children - accidents only takes a moment . . .
