

# TOWNSHIP OF GROSSE ILE BID REQUEST DUST CONTROL

The Township of Grosse Ile is requesting proposals for Dust Control Services. The scope of work includes the provision and application of dust control materials during the calendar year of 2020. The application will be to approximately 64,800 sq. yards of area. The material applied will be DUST BOND brand dust control emulsion or Calcium Chloride dust control material. In the case of Calcium Chloride being the selected product, the material will be applied on two occurrences throughout the summer of 2020 to a total of 129,600 sq. yards of area.
