

# TOWNSHIP OF GROSSE ILE NOTICE TO ELIGIBLE TAXPAYERS APPLICATION FOR DEFERMENT OF 2020 SUMMER TAXES

The Grosse Ile Township Treasurer is currently accepting applications for summer 2020 tax deferments (deferments are not exemptions). To qualify, a household annual income cannot exceed \$40,000. The applicant(s) must also be:

- (1) 62 years of age or older,; 62 years or older, including the unremarried surviving spouse of a person who is 62 years of age or older at the time of death
- (2) paraplegic or quadriplegic
- (3) or an eligible serviceperson, eligible veteran, eligible widow or widower
- (4) a blind person, or
- (5) totally or permanently disabled.

Persons eligible for deferment can only file their deferment until September 14, 2020. ***Approved deferments will defer the payment due date of the summer 2020 tax bill to February 14, 2021.*** Deferments must be filed annually. The applications for deferment are available at the township treasurer's office located at 9601 Groh Road, Grosse Ile, MI or on-line at the treasurer's link at [grosseile.com](http://grosseile.com)
