NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN OBSOLETE PROPERTY REHABILITATION DISTRICT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH ACT 146 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN OF 2000, AS AMENDED

On Monday, September 23rd, 2019, 7:00 PM, the Wyandotte City Council shall conduct a Public Hearing at Wyandotte City Hall, 3200 Biddle Avenue, Wyandotte, Michigan, on the establishment of an Obsolete Property Rehabilitation District for the City of Wyandotte, within which the City Council shall exercise its powers, all pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (OPRA), being Act 146 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 2000, as amended. Said request for the establishing of an OPRA District has been transmitted by the City of Wyandotte Assessor for City Council review and approval.

A description of the property to which the Plan applies is as follows:

Property Address: 166 Oak Street, Wyandotte, County of Wayne, State of Michigan, on the northeast corner of Oak Street and 2nd Street (the previous location of the Wyandotte Post Office).
