## CITY OF WOODHAVEN AMENDED NOXIOUS WEED ORDINANCE

"Notice is hereby given that all excessively grown over 8 inches noxious weeds, as defined by the city Code <a href="section-106.31">section-106.31</a>, growing and all dead grass and weeds or grass over eight inches in height on any land within the City of Woodhaven, County of Wayne, State of Michigan, must be cut down, destroyed, and removed, and when as frequently as growth exceeds maximum height, to prevent such weeds from reaching situation detrimental to the public health and welfare. Provided, however, that such growth shall be permitted if it shall not encroach closer than 50 feet of any public highway, street, sidewalk, adjoining lot or premises. "Failure to comply with this Notice in a timely manner, by allowing such

growth shall make any party so failing liable for the costs of cutting, destroying and removing said noxious weeds and dead grass and brush by said city, said costs to be levied and collected against said lands in the same manner as prescribed by the City Charter an city Code.

"Excluded from this ordinance are lands specifically designated as wetlands or nature areas by the State of Michigan or federal agency, if cutting is prohibited by them."
