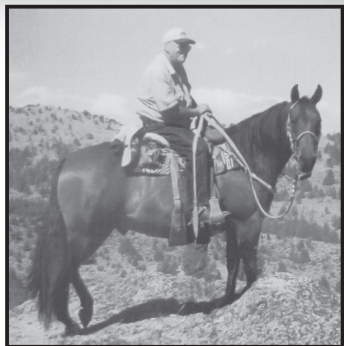


MICHAEL GALBRAITH

Michael Wayne Galbraith passed away at home the morning of Nov. 12, 2019, the day after his 80th birthday, surrounded by family.

Michael was born in Burlington, Iowa, in 1939. He dropped out of high school and went to work on Vanycar Ranch in Durkee, Ore., as a ranch hand until 1959. Mike started driving log truck for Amboy Trucking until the mid 1980's, then went to work for Mckee Logging until they closed up shop. He ended up retiring from Danny Hollister Trucking as a chip truck driver at the age of 70.

Mike had a true passion for horses. He participated in Top 10 Gaming and Team Roping. Mike and his family spent a lot of time in Madras at Cryus Horse Camp riding in the National Grasslands. The family has many fond memories of sitting at camp hearing stories from Mike's early years.
