Mr. Young:

On April 9, 2013, we received your request for the following: All reports pertaining to the death investigation of Molly Young. Your request was denied on May 2, 2013. On June 26, 2013, you requested a review of the denial with the Illinois Attorney General's Public Access Bureau. The State's Attorney from Jackson County has now determined that no charges will be filed and the case is closed. Therefore, the Illinois State Police Freedom of Information Officer, Lieutenant Steve Lyddon, is granting your request in part and denying your request in part for the following reasons:

- **5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b)** – The report is provided with redactions based on the Freedom of Information Act's exemption regarding private information for unique biometric identifiers. Social security numbers, Driver's License numbers and State Identification numbers, etc. will be redacted.
- **5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)** – Personal information which would clearly constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including, but not limited to dates of birth, home addresses, and telephone numbers will be redacted. Some additional personal information has been withheld including, but not limited to an autopsy report and Young's personal journals.

You have the right to have the denial of your request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Attorney General (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a)). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court (5 ILCS 140/11).

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter (5 ILCS 140/9.5(a)). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
