Callie Salem, Norton

The Lancers' junior averaged 10.2 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.25 steals and a team-high 2.25 assists per game. Salem was efficient in pulling up from a distance, scoring at a 31% rate to lead Norton.

Avery Tinkham, Norton

A Tri-Valley League All-Star, Tinkham averaged 11.9 points per game with a 40.2% shooting percentage from the field. The Lancer senior also averaged 3.3 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 assists per game. A central piece in Norton's rotation over the past few years, the two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star closed out her high school career as the No. 9 leading scorer in program history with 770 career points. She also helped Norton make four straight tournament appearances.

Sienna Miranda, Seekonk

Seekonk's 15-win season saw plenty of young, talented hoopsters make their mark and Miranda was one of the senior leaders for the Warriors. A South Coast Conference All-Star for the second time, she averaged 10.1 points, 6.6 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 3.6 steals per game. A two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star, Miranda had three double-doubles, posting a season-high game of 21 points and 13

Leah Hull, Tri-County

Hull led the Cougars in scoring with 8.9 points per game and rebounding at 9.8 boards per game. A nominee for Mayflower Athletic Conference Player of The Year, the junior guard/forward finished the season with 100 steals and eight double-doubles as Tri-County's
