

The Girls Indoor Track All-Stars

S'taarr Parham, Attleboro

The Bombardier junior excelled in both the high jump and long jump, setting a PR of 5-5 at the New England Championship to place fifth in the high jump. Parham also jumped 5-4 multiple times, winning at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational, Hockomock League Championship and MIAA Division 1 Championship while placing sixth at the MIAA Meet of Champions. In the long jump, Parham posted a 16-2 PR at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational and 15-10.75 at the MIAA Division 1 Championship.

Kennedy Samuel, Attleboro

Samuel had a strong sophomore season in the 300 meters, setting a 42.85 PR at the Hockomock League Championship for fourth place and ran 43.08 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for eighth place. Samuel also posted 43.38 at the MIAA Division 1 Championship to finish 13th. She was a key member of the 4x200 relay team, contributing to Attleboro's solid performances throughout the season.

Emilia Smith, Attleboro

Smith, a senior, had a standout season in the mile and 1,000 meters. Her top mile time was a 5:10.02 PR at the MIAA Division 1 Championship, placing sixth. Smith also ran 5:18.67 at the MIAA Meet of Champions for 12th place and 5:26.01 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational. In the 1,000 meters, the two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star posted a 3:06.24 PR at the Hockomock League Championship for fourth place and ran 3:10.34 at the MIAA Meet of Champions for 15th place.

Tea Briggs, Bishop Feehan

Briggs excelled in the 300 meters this season as the senior posted a PR of 43.32 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship to finish fifth. She ran 43.36 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for 11th place and 43.59 at the MAC Championship, where she placed second. Briggs also posted a 7.73 PR in the 55 dash and contributed to the MAC champion 4x400 relay team, which placed second at the MIAA Division 2 Championship.

Jillian Olson, Bishop Feehan

Olson impressed in the 1,000 meters for the Shamrocks. The senior set a PR of 3:04.71 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship for third place and ran 3:08.68 at the MSTCA Northeast Invitational for eighth. Olson also posted 3:07.14 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for ninth place. She helped the Shamrocks' 4x800 relay team place second at the MIAA Division 2 Championship and third at the MIAA Meet of Champions.

Brooke Serak, Bishop Feehan

The senior for the Shamrocks was dominant in the shot put, recording a PR of 39-11.75 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship to claim first place. Serak also won the MAC Championship and placed third at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational with a 38-1.25 mark. The multiple-time Sun Chronicle

Faith Bober, Foxboro

Bober set a PR of 8.98 in the 55-meter hurdles at the MIAA Division 4 Championship, finishing fifth in the finals. The Warriors' junior also ran 9.11 in the finals. Bober posted PRs of 4-8 in the high jump, 15-4.25 in the long jump and 45.18 in the 300 meters, demonstrating her versatility. She was integral to the Warriors' success in relay events, contributing to both the 4x200 and 4x400 relays.

Lauren Bober, Foxboro

The Foxboro junior flashed in the 55 dash with a 7.52 PR. Bober placed 12th at the MIAA Division 4 Championship with a 7.68. She was also strong in the 300 meters. Bober set a season best of 42.91 and later ran 43.73 at the MIAA Division 4 Championship for 12th place. She also posted a 1:42.47 PR in the 600 meters, earning third place at the Hockomock League Championship, as well as a 1:42.85 mark at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational.

Alex D'Amadio, King Philip

D'Amadio had an impressive junior season in the long jump, setting a PR of 17-4.75 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship to claim the title. The two-time Sun

Chronicle All-Star jumped 17-0.5 at the MIAA Meet of Champions for 13th and 16-5.25 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for 11th. In the 55 dash, D'Amadio posted a 7.44 PR at the Hockomock League Championship and ran 7.47 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship, earning fourth place at both.

Madeline Hill, King Philip

Hill was a mainstay in both the 55 hurdles and long jump in her final season. The senior ran a 9.08 PR at the Hockomock League Championship to place third and 9.25 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for eighth. Hill posted a PR of 16-4.25 in the long jump at the James Kalperis Relays and recorded 15-2.5 at both the MSTCA Coaches Invitational and Hockomock League Championship, finishing 31st and sixth, respectively.

Danielle Lomuscio, King Philip

Competing in her final season for the Warriors, Lomuscio stood out in the 1,000 meters and 600 meters. The senior posted a PR of 3:03.46 in the 1,000 at the New England Championship to place 12th and ran 3:05.23 at the Hockomock League Championship for second. Lomuscio also ran 3:08.92 at the MIAA Division 2 Championship for ninth place. In the 600 meters, she set a PR of 1:45.52 during the season and was a key contributor to the 4x400 relay team.

THE GIRLS INDOOR TRACK ALL-STARS were selected with local coaches consulted for their recommendations.

Chloe Guthrie, Mansfield

Guthrie turned in a 41.80 PR in the 300 meters at the MIAA Meet of Champions for 11th place. The Hornets senior also ran 41.99 at the Hockomock League Championship to finish second and 41.97 at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational for fifth place. In the 55-meters dash, Guthrie ran a PR of 7.15 at the New England Championship, finishing eighth; was third at the MIAA Division 3 Championship, and placed second at the Hockomock League Championship and MSTCA Coaches Invitational with times of 7.21 and 7.25. Guthrie is a multiple-time Sun Chronicle All-Star.

Sarah Jones, Mansfield

Only a freshman, Jones had an impressive debut, posting a 1:41.33 PR in the 600 meters at the MSTCA Coaches Invitational to finish ninth. She also ran 1:43.13 at the MIAA Division 3 Championship for ninth place and 1:44.30 at the MSTCA Boston Holiday Challenge for 11th. In the 1,000 meters, Jones set a PR of 3:20.43 during the season and contributed to the Hornets' 4x400 and sprint medley relays.
