GIRLS OUTDOOR TRACK: The Sun Chronicle All-Stars

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Avery Parkinson, North Attleboro

Parkinson thrived in both the 400 and 800 over her senior season, placing seventh in the Division 3 Meet in the 400. At New Englands, she continued her success with an 11th-place finish in the 800 and clocked a personal-best time of 12:15 at the Meet of Champions. Parkinson was second in the 800 at the Hockomock League Championships and a Hockomock League All-Star.

Julia Smith, North Attleboro

The Rocketeers' senior was a versatile competitor, scoring for North on the track and in the field. At the Meet of Champions, the senior two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star ran a personal-best time in the 400 and took 10th in the 400 hurdles. At the New England Championships, she had an 18th-place finish in the long jump.

Molly McIntyre, Norton

McIntyre earned top-10 finishes for Norton in both the mile and two-mile at the MIAA Division 5 Meet, placing ninth in the mile and eighth in the two-mile. The Lancers' senior was also the anchor leg for

Norton's 14th-place 4x800 relay team at the Division 5 Meet.

Julianna Dutra, Seekonk

The Warriors' senior was second in both the 100 and 200 in the MIAA Division 6 Meet with respective times of 12.83 and 25.80. She was also the anchor leg of Seekonk's 4x100 relay as Seekonk placed fifth at the meet. At the Meet of Champions, Dutra took 24th in the 200 and competed in the 100, but did not make it out of the preliminary heats. The two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star was clutch for Seekonk in winning the South Coast Conference Championships, placing first in the 200 in 25.58 and taking second in the 100.

Hayden Robinson, Seekonk

Robinson won the Division 6 Meet title in the 800 with a time of 2:17.73, and took ninth in the mile. The senior two-time Sun Chronicle All-Star was also eighth in the 200. Robinson earned a spot at the Meet of Champions, where she placed 10th in the 800 with a two-second improvement on her divisional time, clocking out at 2:15.16. She also was the 800 champ at the South Coast Conference Championships in 2:18.72.
