ON 07/26/2021 AT APPROXIMATELY 5:30 PM I PSO. II L. DUKES RESPONDED TO A CALL FOR SERVICE AT 741 COLLETON STREET ORANGEBURG S.C. 29115, IN REFERENCE TO A MAN WITH A GUN. WHEN I ARRIVED ON SCENE I COULD SEE A MAN THAT WAS MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION NEAR THE CALLER FRONT DOOR. THE MAN WAS WALKING AWAY FROM MY DIRECTION AS I WAS ARRIVING ON SCENE IN A FAST MANNER. WHEN I EXITED MY VEHICLE I COULD SEE A GRAY OBJECT IN THE SUBJECT HAND THAT APPEARED TO BE A GUN. I DREW MY DUTY WEAPON AND GAVE THE SUBJECT VERBAL COMMANDS TO LET ME SEE HIS HANDS. THE SUBJECT WAS NOT COMPLYING, THE SUBJECT CONTINUED TO WALK AWAY. THE SUBJECT STOPPED BEHIND THE FRONT OF A VEHICLE AND APPEARED TO BE BENDING DOWN NEAR THE VEHICLE FRONT TIRE DOING SOMTHING. Supervisor's Comments

OFFICERS RESPONDED TO 741 COLLETON ST IN REFERENCE TO A SUBJECT WITH A GUN ON HIS SIDE STANDING IN FRONT OF THE RESIDENCE. DISPATCH THEN ADVISED THAT THE SUBJECT WAS NOW BEATING ON THE DOOR AND WINDOW. PSOII DUKES WAS THE FIRST OFFICER ON SCENE FOLLOWED BY CPL. SMITH, AND SGT. POLIDORE AND MYSELF, SGT. MAIER. WHEN I GOT ON SCENE SUBJECT GAILYARD WAS ON THE GROUND AND IN HANDCUFFS. AS I APPROACHED I OBSERVED AN ABRASION ON THE CENTER OF HIS FOREHEAD AND HE WAS STATING THAT PSOII DUKES HAD PUSHED HIS HEAD INTO THE GROUND. MULTIPLE OTHER SUBJECTS ON SCENE ALSO STATED THAT EXCESSIVE FORCE WAS USED ON SUBJECT GAILYARD.

AFTER REVIEWING ALL BODY CAMERAS OF OFFICERS ON SCENE I SAW PSOII DUKES ARRIVE ON SCENE FIRST. AS PSOII DUKES EXITS HIS PATROL CAR HE IMMEDIATELY GIVE A LOUD VERBAL COMMAND OF "LET ME SEE YOUR HANDS". HE IS THEN SEEN DRAWING HIS SERVICE WEAPON AND ORDERING TWO SUBJECTS TO "GET ON THE GROUND". ONE SUBJECT WEARING A WHITE T-SHIRT AND JEAN SHORTS THEN COMPLYS AND LAYS ON THE GROUND. PSOII DUKES THE TURNS HIS ATTENTION TO SUBJECT GAILYARD WHO IS WEARING A BURGUNDY SHIRT AND JEAN SHORTS. SUBJECT CAN BE SEEN BEHIND A WHITE SUV PARKED IN FRONT OF APT#741 AND HE THEN WALKS OUT WITH HIS HANDS UP TOWARDS PSOII DUKES WHO IS STILL GIVING LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS FOR SUBJECT TO "GET ON THE GROUND". PSOII DUKES IS THEN SEEN APPROACHING SUBJECT GAILYARD AS SUBJECT BEGINS TO GET ON THE GROUND. SUBJECT GETS AS FAR AS ON HIS KNEES AND HAD BOTH HANDS ON THE GROUND IN FRONT OF HIM WHEN PSOII DUKES IS SEEN STOMPING ON THE BACK OF SUBJECTS NECK CAUSING HIS FOREHEAD TO STRIKE THE CONCRETE. PSOII DUKES THEN HANDCUFFS SUBJECT TO THE REAR OF HIS PERSON AND SEARCHES HIM FOR WEAPONS, WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. A MAKESHIFT BLUNT OBJECT WAS LOCATED UNDER THE WHITE SUV WHERE SUBJECT WAS STANDING WHEN PSOII DUKES ARRIVED ON SCENE. THE OBJECT WAS SOME SORT OF STICK WITH DUCK TAPE WRAPPED AROUND IT.

AFTER VIEWING ALL BODY CAMERA FOOTAGE I DO BELIEVE THAT PSOII DUKES WAS IN VIOLATION OF DEPARTMENT POLICY AND EXCESSIVE FORCE WAS USED WHEN PSOII DUKES STOMPED ON THE BACK OF SUBJECT GAILYARDS NECK.

Comments:

During this incident Officer Dukes arrives on scene and encounters two male subjects. Officer Dukes can be seen exiting his patrol vehicle and began giving commands of "show me your hands" to the two subjects. The first subject wearing a white shirt puts his hands up and is walking towards Dukes, Dukes gives commands of "get on the ground", the subject in the white shirt then gets on the ground in the prone position. Dukes then directs commands of "show me your hands" to the other subject wearing a red shirt, the subject is at this time walking in front of a white SUV towards Dukes. The second subject was moving slowly towards dukes and his hands can be seen by his side and then go up to show that his hands were empty. Dukes then begins giving the command to "get on the ground" the subject moving slowly was getting down on the ground, he had made it to his knees and his hands were on the ground. Dukes can then be seen walking up on the subjects left side a deliver a kick with his right foot to the back of the subjects neck, causing the subjects head to hit the ground. The subject sustained injuries from the kick.

The Primary Force that was used by Officer Dukes is inconsistent with Department policy which states ". In no instance, will employees use primary force in excess of that which is reasonable and necessary to lawfully and properly neutralize an unlawful assault or overcome resistance by a person being taken into custody."

Officer Dukes did use excessive force when kicking the subject in the back of the neck.
