SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT

ON 07/26/2021 AT APPROXIMATELY 1710 HOURS OFFICERS AND MYSELF (CPL B. SMITH) WAS DISPATCH TO [REDACTED] ORANGEBURG SC, 29115 IN REFERENCE TO A BLACK MALE WEARING A BURGUNDY SHIRT AND BLUE SHORTS WITH A GUN IN HIS WAISTBAND BANGING / HITTING ON A FEMALE DOOR TRYING TO GET INSIDE. THIS INCIDENT LOCATION IS INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF ORANGEBURG SC.

ON ARRIVAL I OBSERVED TWO BLACK MALES ONE GETTING ON THE GROUND WEARING A WHITE SHIRT AND ONE BLACK MALE WEARING A BURGUNDY SHIRT MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION THAT WAS GIVEN. THE BLACK MALE WEARING THE BURGUNDY SHIRT, NOW KNOWN AS SUBJECT CLARENCE GAILYARD, WAS WALKING FROM THE PASSENGER SIDE OF A WHITE VEHICLE AND APPEARED TO HAVE HIS HANDS IN HIS POCKETS. ONCE HE REACHED THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE HE TOOK HIS HANDS OUT OF HIS POCKETS. PSO II DUKES WAS GIVING LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS FOR SUBJECT GAILYARD TO GET ON THE GROUND BUT SUBJECT GAILYARD DID NOT COMPLY AND KEPT WALKING TOWARDS OFFICERS. AS THIS WAS HAPPENING OTHER PEOPLE STARTED COMING OUT OF THE APARTMENTS MAKING THE SCENE UNSECURED. PSO II DUKES THEN WALKED TOWARDS SUBJECT GAILYARD STILL GIVING LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS TO GET ON THE GROUND. SUBJECT GAILYARD STARTED TO COMPLY BUT WOULD NOT COMPLETELY GET ON THE GROUND. PSO II DUKES THEN TOOK HIS RIGHT FOOT PLACING IT ON THE SUBJECT GAILYARD BACK (MIDDLE OF SUBJECT GAILYARD BACK) PUSHING HIM TO THE GROUND. SUBJECT GAILYARD WAS STILL TALKING AT THIS TIME. PSO II DUKES WAS THEN ABLE TO DETAIN SUBJECT WHILE I WENT TO

PSO II DUKES WAS ABLE TO LOCATE A SILVER DUCK TAPED WEAPON OF SOME SORT ON THE PASSENGER SIDE OF THE VEHICLE. I THEN ASSISTED SUBJECT GAILYARD UP AND HE WAS ASKED IF HE NEEDED EMS DUE TO A SCRATCH MARK ON HIS FOREHEAD AND HE DID REQUEST MEDICAL ATTENTION. DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: ON 07/26/2021 AT APPROXIMATELY 1710 HOURS OFFICERS AND MYSELF (CPL B. SMITH) WAS DISPATCH TO 741 COLLETON ST ORANGEBURG SC, 29115 IN REFERENCE TO A BLACK MALE WEARING A BURGUNDY SHIRT AND BLUE SHORTS WITH A GUN IN HIS WAISTBAND BANGING / HITTING ON A FEMALES DOOR TRYING TO GET INSIDE. THIS INCIDENT LOCATION IS INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF ORANGEBURG SC.

ON ARRIVAL I OBSERVED TWO BLACK MALES ONE GETTING ON GROUND WEARING A WHITE SHIRT AND ONE BLACK MALE WEARING A BURGUNDY SHIRT MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION THAT WAS GIVEN. THE BLACK MALE WEARING THE BURGUNDY SHIRT IS NOW KNOWN AS SUBJECT CLARENCE GAILYARD WAS WALKING FROM THE PASSENGER SIDE OF A WHITE VEHICLE WITH WHAT APPEARED TO BE HIS HANDS IN HIS POCKETS, THEN AT THE FRONT OF THE VEHICLE TOOK HIS HANDS OUT OF HIS POCKETS. PSO II DUKES WAS GIVING LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS FOR SUBJECT GAILYARD TO GET ON THE GROUND SUBJECT GAILYARD DID NOT COMPLY AND KEPT WALKING TOWARDS OFFICERS. AS THIS WAS HAPPENING OTHER PEOPLE STARTED COMING OUT THE APARTMENTS MAKING THE SCENE UNSECURE. PSO II DUKES THEN WALKED TOWARDS SUBJECT GAILYARD STILL GIVING LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS TO GET ON THE GROUND. SUBJECT GAILYARD STARTED TO COMPLY BUT WOULD NOT COMPLETELY GET ON THE GROUND. PSO II DUKES THEN TOOK HIS RIGHT FOOT PLACING IT ON SUBJECT GAILYARD BACK (MIDDLE OF SUBJECT GAILYARD BACK) PUSHING HIM TO THE GROUND. SUBJECT GAILYARD WAS STILL TALKING AT THIS TIME. PSO II DUKES WAS THEN ABLE TO DETAIN HIM WHILE I WENT TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE WHITE VEHICLE LOOKING FOR THE GUN.

I LOOKED IN THE BUSHES, UNDER THE WHITE VEHICLE AND ABOVE THE TIRES OF THE VEHICLE AND DID NOT OBSERVE A GUN. PSO II DUKES WAS ABLE TO LOCATE A SILVER DUCKED TAPED WEAPON OF SOME SORT ON THE PASSENGER SIDE OF THE VEHICLE. I THEN HELP ASSISTED SUBJECT GAILYARD UP AND HE WAS ASKED IF HE NEEDED EMS DUE TO A SCRATCH MARK ON HIS FOREHEAD. SUBJECT GAILYARD DID HAVE A STRONG ODOR OF ALCOHOL COMING FROM HIS PERSON. DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: ON 07/26/2021 AT APPROXIMATELY 1715 HOURS I, CPL. HAMPTON RESPONDED TO 741 COLLETON STREET IN REFERENCE TO A BLACK MALE SUBJECT KNOCKING AT THE DOOR WITH A GUN ON HIS HIP. UPON ARRIVAL SGT. MAIER, SGT. POLIDORE, CPL. SMITH AND PSO. DUKES WAS ALREADY ON SCENE. I OBSERVED A BLACK MALE SUBJECT LATER IDENTIFIED AS CLARENCE GAILYARD IN HANDCUFFS STANDING NEXT TO CPL. SMITH BLEEDING FROM THE CENTER OF HIS FOREHEAD. I HEARD SUBJECT GAILYARD CONSTANTLY YELLING AT PSO. DUKES SAYING "MAN WHY YOU DID THAT TO ME YOU ANT HAD TO SLAM MY HEAD ON THE PAVEMENT LIKE THAT YOU WRONG". AT THAT POINT STILL DID NOT KNOW WHAT TOOK PLACE UNTIL I WAS IN THE PROCESS OF MARANDIZING SUBJECT GAILYARD AND SGT. POLIDORE PULLED ME TO THE SIDE AND ADVISED THAT THE COMPLAINANTS DIDN'T WANT TO PRESS CHARGES AND STATED THAT SHE OBSERVED PSO. DUKES STOMP SUBJECT GAILYARD WHO WAS ON HIS HANDS AND KNEES AT THE TIME ON HIS NECK CAUSING HIS HEAD TO COLLIDE WITH THE PAVEMENT. AT THAT TIME WENT OVER TO MY PATROL VEHICLE TO GET THE SHIFT CAMERA AND TOOK PHOTOS OF SUBJECT GAILYARD, HIS INJURIES AND THE LOCATION IN THE PARKING LOT WHERE THE FORCE WAS USED. ORANGEBURG COUNTY EMS ARRIVED ON SCENE SHORTLY AFTER AND TRANSPORTED SUBJECT GAILYARD TO THE REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER. THE PHOTOS I TOOK ON SCENE WILL BE UPLOADED TO A DISC AND PLACED IN TO EVIDENCE. WHILE OTHER OFFICERS CLEARED THE SCENE I STAYED WITH SGT. POLIDORE WHILE SHE SPOKE WITH WITNESSES WHILE THEY WROTE VOLUNTARY STATEMENTS ON WHAT THE OBSERVED BETWEEN PSO. DUKES AND SUBJECT GAILYARD.

DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION:

At approximately 5:05 pm, I was at the Samaritan House, located on Russell street, within the city limits of Orangeburg. At about 5:10 pm. City dispatch gave a call to Bravo 102, Brandi Smith, to respond to 741 Colleton Street, located within the city limits of Orangeburg, about a male subject with a gun on his hip refusing to leave the yard. Brandi replied she was enroute, I asked City dispatch to repeat the address because my radio cut out, and she did. I then replied that I was enroute from the samaritan house, then Dukes came across the radio stating that he was in enroute as well. The City Dispatcher came across the radio again and noted that the complainant (Ms. Ben) advised the subject is now banging on the door.

As I approached Boulevard from Ellis ave, Officer Dukes cut across Ellis from the Boulevard, with Brandi right behind him with her lights on. Brandi's lights activated my body worn-camera. Dukes signed off that he was on the scene, then I signed off that I was on the scene, then Brandi stated the same traffic, respectively. As I put the vehicle in park, I saw Dukes with his gun drawn, pointing it at Mr. Gaillyard. I could not see Mr. Gaillyard at the time because Brandi and Duke's vehicle was blocking my view. I yelled out to myself in disbelief, "what is he doing" I put the car in park, opened the door, and said, "Oh God!" Dukes walked closer to Mr. Gaillyard, yelling at him to get on the ground. Mr. Gaillyard carefully got on the ground, laying flat with his hands up, and Dukes jumped up and stomped Mr. Gaillyard on the back of his neck with his foot and stated, "I said get on the ground." then handcuffed him. Dukes told Randi to look for the gun behind the truck. Randi said there is no gun; there is no gun. Dukes then walked away from Mr. Gaillyard and over to Brandi to look for a gun and said Polidore watch him for me. I just shook my head in disbelief.

I then asked city dispatch to give me the suspect's description, and she stated he is wearing a burgundy shirt. I cautiously walked towards Mr. Mario Julien (DOB 5/29/88; ██████████ Oburg, SC; ██████████) that Dukes ordered to the ground (who was uncuffed) and asked what is going on? Mr. Julien said he did not know he just came over here because his cousin (Mr. Gaillyard) asked him. I kindly requested Mr. Julien to get up from the ground. I then saw Dukes and Randi pick Mr. Gaillyard from off the ground. Mr. Gaillyard was complaining about his head. I asked Dukes and Randi multiple times if Mr. Gaillyard needed EMS? Neither one of them answered. I walked over to where they were to get a better look at Mr. Gaillyard injury and saw that Mr. Gaillyard's forehead was bleeding. I then called for EMS to respond. Mr. Gaillyard kept saying, "you bust my head down; you throw me down." Dukes responded to Mr. Gaillyard sarcastically, "I sure did. You were not listening." Mr. Gaillyard replied to Dukes and said, "you did not have to throw me down."

Sgt Maier arrived on the scene, and then Dukes started to explain what was going on. See body-cam number 2103274. Dukes said that "Mr. Gaillyard had a stick in his hand, and I thought it was a gun." Dukes said, "Mr. Gaillyard put the stick down and had his hands in his pocket." Dukes said that he "ordered Mr. Gaillyard to the ground, and then they both fell on the ground, and that is what happened." I shook my head in disbelief, motioned for Maier to come to speak with me, and told Sgt. Maier that he is not telling the truth. Dukes kicked Mr. Gaillyard in the neck.

Then ██████████ came outside from apartment 741, upset about what he witnessed, and stated, that's fucked up stomping that man on the neck like that. I then heard ██████████ (St. Orangeburg) yelling and fussing, saying that she did not want to call the police. I asked her did she want to file a police report and who had the gun? Ms. Glen stated, No, I do not want the police here. I did not see a gun!

I then walked over to Cpl Hampton, who was reading Mr. Gaillyard his Miranda Rights, and advised that ██████████ does not want to file a report and there was not a gun. Brandi uncuffed Mr. Gaillyard, and Mr. Gaillyard left with EMS.

██████████ (DOB 7/25/81;4005 ██████████) walked over to me and asked what officer Duke's name and badge number were. I advised ██████████ to walk over to him, request it, and ask that he put it on a card. I walked over to Officer Dukes with ██████████ and when ██████████ asked for the badge number Dukes responded 1059. ██████████ then asked if he could provide it with the card. Dukes told ██████████ that the agency does not give cards. I immediately stated to ██████████ yes, we do; here is a card. I pulled the departmental issued contact card out of my pocket, wrote Duke's name on it, asked Dukes for his badge number again, wrote it down on the card, and gave it to Mr. Guinyard.

I walked back to ██████████, where ██████████, Mr. Julien, and ██████████ were standing and visibly upset. I asked if they would like to provide a voluntary statement, and they all said yes. Mr. Demario Julien and ██████████ provided voluntary statements of their accounts.

I left Colleton street and immediately called Captain Alexander to inform him what was going on. He thanked me for letting him know and to advise Sgt. Maier to notify the Captain on call and to let him know who is doing the report. I arrived at agency headquarters and spoke with Sgt. Maier in the parking lot and informed him of what Captain Alexander said. Sgt. Maier and I had a brief discussion about who was doing the report. I asked Maier if he was writing it? He replied I thought you were writing it. I said, Dukes, need to write it. He is the one who drew the gun and stomped on that Man neck! I replied, I am reporting what I saw and what he did! and I am too upset and exhausted

and unable to make a statement tonight. Maier said, well, I was trying to keep Dukes out of it. I said for what? Maier replied Dukes is going to write a supplemental and Use of Force Report. I said, well, somebody needs to do one! Hell, the call was given to Brandi. Dukes and Brandi were the first on the scene. I do not even know why he had his gun drawn. The complainant decided not to file a report, but a report will be filed with all that took place.

I went inside agency headquarters and informed Colonel Conner what Dukes did. I then went into the squad room to upload and label the body-cam footage. At the same time, I was viewing the footage to document information for my report. I asked Dukes for the name of the gentleman that went to the hospital. Dukes replied in a nasty tone, "are you doing the report?" I looked at him and said I need the name of the man that went to the hospital? He replied again in a nasty tone, What man? I said, "the man you handcuffed and stomped on his neck!" He replied I did not stomp on anybody's neck. I replied, so, are you refusing to provide what I need?
