## Offenses:

ASSISTING ANOTHER AGENCY (SCSU PD)

ON 02/12/2026 AT 2101 DISPATCH ADVISED OF A SHOOTING AT HUGINE SUITES SCSU WHICH IS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ORANGEBURG SOUTH CAROLINA. SCSU POLICE DEPARTMENT WAS REQUESTING ASSISTANCE FROM THE ORANGEBURG DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AT THE HUGINE SUITES WITH THREE PEOPLE SHOT.

UPON ARRIVAL OUR UNITS ASSIST WITH SCSU PD, SECURING THE SCENE FOR EMS. THE SCENE WAS SECURED AND SGT. HAMPTON, PSO TYLER, PSO McDUFFIE, PSO ADAMS AND LT. WALKER HELP ASSIST EMS WITH LIFE SAVING PROCEDURES AND CARRIED OUT TWO VICTIMS DOWN THREE FLIGHT OF STAIRS. PSO EPPS AND PSO WRIGHT HELP SECURE THE DOWN STAIR AREA ALONG WITH SCSU PD, AND SECURITY CONTROLLING THE STUDENTS. SCSU PD, CAPT. ROBINSON REQUESTED FOR ONE OF OUR UNITS TO ASSIST THEM WITH AN OFFICER AT MUSC WHERE THE TWO VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED. PSO WRIGHT AND PSO TYLER WENT TO MUSC AND WAS ABLE TO GATHER SOME INFORMATION ON THE VICTIMS. I DID ADVISED DISPATCH TO NOTIFY COMMAND STAFF.

CHIEF AUSTIN AND CHIEF JHONSON ARRIVED ON SCENE AND SHORTLY AFTER SLED ARRIVED. SLED REQUESTED SOME OF OUR UNITS TO STAY ON THE SCENE UNTIL THEY COMPLETE THE CRIME SCENE PROCESS. SGT. HAMPTON AND PSO McDUFFIE STAYED ON SCENE. ORANGEBURG COUNTY UNITS AND SLED ARRIVED AT MUSC AND OUR UNITS WAS RELEASED FROM MUSC. THE ORANGEBURG COUNTY CORNER ARRIVED ON SCENE FOR ONE OF THE VICTIM THAT WAS DECEASED UPON OUR ARRIVAL. AT 2300 OUR UNITS WAS WAS ALL

DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: On 02/12/2026 at approximately 2101 hours, I, Pao II Adams, was checking the property at University Village located at 300 College Avenue when a call for shots fired was broadcast over the city dispatch radio. City dispatch advised that SC State Campus was requesting assistance from city and county units.

Upon arrival on scene, I was flagged down by several students who advised that the shooting occurred at Huggins Suites. I responded to that location and observed SC State security officers and campus police on scene. Officers were yelling for me to respond to the third floor.

I proceeded to the third floor and observed a Black male lying on the floor outside of Room [REDACTED] in a flooded hallway.

The male appeared to have sustained gunshot wounds to the [REDACTED] and the left side of his [REDACTED]. An SC State officer was attending to him.

I then entered Room [REDACTED] and observed two male subjects lying near the doorway. One of the males appeared to have sustained a gunshot wound to the [REDACTED] area. I checked the male for a pulse and observed that he was not breathing. I immediately began performing CPR until medical personnel arrived on scene.

I continued CPR until deputy sheriffs arrived and relieved me.

I briefly exited the scene to retrieve additional gloves and my medical kit; however, my medical kit was not in my vehicle. EMS arrived shortly thereafter, took over patient care, and assessed the male subject. EMS personnel checked for cardiac rhythm and advised that the subject was deceased.

After EMS assumed control of the scene, I exited the building and assisted with securing the perimeter, concluding my involvement in the incident.

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DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: On 02/12/2026, I, PSO C. Tyler, responded to Hugine suites at SC State in reference to shots fired on campus. Upon arrival at Dorm [REDACTED] I saw an unknown black male lying outside the door, claiming to have been shot.

As I entered the room, I saw another unknown black male lying supine on the floor with PSO Adams performing chest compressions. I checked this male for pulse with a negative result.

I then checked the second unknown black male lying behind the first male. He was breathing slowly and very shallow. I did not see any blood or obvious wounds, with the exception of blood in his mouth. With security officer Brooks holding the C-spine, the unknown male was log rolled and could not find any wounds. A deputy produced a pair of trauma shears and cut the unknown male's clothes off. One possible GSW was found on his right [REDACTED]

Once the ambulance arrived, we placed him on a e-stretcher and carried him down three flights of stairs to the stretcher. The second unknown male who was laying outside the room was placed on an E-stretcher and carried down three flights of stairs and placed on another stretcher.

I then proceeded to MUSC, as SC state had no officers to spare at that moment.

DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: ON 02/12/2026 AT APPROXIMATELY 2100 HOURS I, SGT. HAMPTON RESPONDED TO HUGINE SUITES BUILDING B WHICH IS LOCATED ON THE CAMPUS OF SOUTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY IN REFERENCE TO CALL FOR ASSISTANCE. COMMUNICATIONS ADVISED PER SOUTH CAROLINA STATE PD THEY JUST HAD A SHOOTING INCIDENT WHERE SEVERAL SUBJECTS WERE SHOT AND THEY WERE REQUESTING OUR ASSISTANCE. UPON ARRIVAL SCSU LIEUTENANT ASKED THAT I ASSIST BY PUTTING UP CRIME SCENE TAPE WHILE HE AND OTHER OFFICERS ASSESSED THE INJURED SUBJECTS ON THE THIRD FLOOR. ONCE ORANGEBURG COUNTY EMS ARRIVED ON SCENE I WENT UP STAIRS TO ASSIST OFFICER IN BRINGING THE GUN SHOT VICTIM DOWN THE STAIRS ON THE BACK BOARD. AFTER WE WAS ABLE TO PLACE THE MALE SUBJECT ON THE STRETCHER I WENT BACK UP STAIRS TO ASSIST WITH PRESERVING THE EVIDENCE AND MAKING SURE THE STUDENTS IN NEIGHBORING ROOM DIDN'T ENTER THE CRIME SCENE. ONCE SCSU INVESTIGATOR EVACUATED THE FEMALES FROM THE ROOM WHERE THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE AND SLED AGENTS ARRIVED ON SCENE I THEN RELOCATED DOWN STAIRS AND ASSISTED WITH KEEPING STUDENTS AWAY FROM ENTERING THE CRIME SCENE. SLED CAPTAIN ASKED IF ODPS OFFICERS COULD STAND BY FOR CROWD CONTROL WHILE HIS AGENTS PROCESS THE SCENE AND CONDUCT THEIR INVESTIGATION. ONCE SCSU WAS ABLE TO FREE UP OFFICERS FROM OTHER AREAS OF THE CAMPUS THE SLED CAPTAIN ON SCENE ADVISED THAT ODPS OFFICERS WERE FREE TO CLEAR THE SCENE. DUE TO IT BEING AN ACTIVE SCENE I WAS UNABLE TO GET THE NAMES OF THE SUBJECTS INVOLVED IN THE INCIDENT.

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DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: ON 2/12/2026 AT APPROXIMATELY 2100 HOURS I, PSO MCDUFFIE RESPONDED TO 116 HOLLINSHED RD, ORANGEBURG SC 29115 WHICH IS LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF ORANGEBURG DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

COMMUNICATIONS ADVISED THAT SHOTS WERE FIRED ON SOUTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS AND CAMPUS POLICE REQUESTED ASSISTANCE FROM ORANGEBURG DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY. UPON ARRIVAL TO HUGINE SUITES(BUILDING B) RM# [REDACTED] A UNKNOWN BLACK MALE WAS LAYING IN THE WALK WAY AREA IN FRONT OF RM# [REDACTED] DOOR STATING HE WAS SHOT, WHILE RECEIVING MEDICAL TREATMENT FROM A SC STATE POLICE OFFICER AND WAS PLACED A BACKBOARD. UPON MAKING ENTRY INTO RM# [REDACTED] ANOTHER UNKNOWN BLACK MALE WAS LAYING ON HIS BACK RECEIVING CPR FROM PSO II ADAMS. A THIRD UNKNOWN BLACK MALE WAS LYING ON HIS BACK NEAR THE DORM BEDROOM WHILE BREATHING SHALLOW AND WAS PLACED ON A E-STRETCHER, CARRIED DOWN 3 FLIGHTS OF STAIRS AND PLACED INTO THE AMBULANCE.

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DETAILED STATEMENT OF INVESTIGATION: On Thursday 12th, 2026 at approximately 9:01p.m., I Public Safety Officer II (PSOII) Ezra Epps was checking property behind the Zimmerman Community Center, when Dispatch stated that South Carolina State University Public Safety was requesting assistance with a shooting.

Upon my arrival to Huggins Suites, I noticed that numerous emergency personnel were trying to remove students from the area, and place up crime scene tape around the building's entry/exit hallways.

When I heard on scene officers talking about needing Emergency Medical Services as close to the building as possible while standing outside on the ground, I explained to Sergeant Hampton that I would go back to the main roadway and try to direct ambulances and other law enforcement personnel to the location and make sure that no vehicles were blocking any major avenues.

When Emergency Medical Services arrived, I moved back to Huggins Suites and assisted by carrying the paramedic backpacks down to the ambulances. When all the ambulances left the scene, I returned back to the main road entrance with my patrol vehicle to help with traffic control and to provide some directions for the South Carolina Law-Enforcement Division Agents that were coming on scene.

I cleared the location at 11:59 when all remaining officers from Bravo Shift were cleared.
