

Rev^d John Gussendanner between the year 1738 and 1749. who was until the year 1749 a minister of the Lutheran Church. In 1749 He went to England and received Episcopal ordination from Dr. Sheelock, Bishop of London He was ordained a Deacon Aug^t 27 and Priest Sept 24 1749 He returned to this District Orangeburg and died in 1761. The foregoing Record of Baptisms is what He had done before His Ordination in the Church of England. See note of above in Dalcho Church History page 333 I, John Lucas copied the above after having it translated. Nov 29 1861

The Said Rev^d Gussendanner was buried in the Church yard of Orangeburg His wife Barbara was also Buried in the same place see p^g 75. He lost several Children³. I do not know nor can I find out where the Baptisms as per this record was performed. If there had been a Church Building it would have had most likely a name given to it. He makes no mention of a Church Building or a name but calls or says that the Person has been Baptised or received into the congregation of Gods people or into the Holy Church of God. which shows He had a congregation & perhaps a settled place of worship. Though not mentioned. Perhaps the place was in this old grave yard, which I think very Doubtful. on account of the absence of any Records of Burials until the year 1749, see Record. see page 275 of this Book which seems^{to be} the first Burial therein.
