

**FORT WORTH INDEPENDENT
SCHOOL DISTRICT RESOLUTION
DISAPPROVING OF THE TARRANT
APPRAISAL DISTRICT
2025 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, Fort Worth Independent School District is a taxing entity within the Tarrant Appraisal District and relies on the Tarrant Appraisal District for appraising property within the boundaries of the county for ad valorem tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Tarrant Appraisal District operations are funded solely by the local taxing entities served by the appraisal district, which includes Fort Worth Independent School District; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2024, the Tarrant Appraisal District Board of Directors voted to approve its 2025 Budget in the amount of \$33,585,297, an increase of 14.12% from the current 2024 budget; and

WHEREAS, Fort Worth Independent School District's portion of Tarrant Appraisal District's budget has increased from \$2,856,909 in 2024 to an estimated amount of \$3,252,906 in 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Texas Property Tax Code, each taxing unit has a right to adopt a resolution disapproving of the Tarrant Appraisal District budget, and

WHEREAS, the Section 6.06(b) of the Texas Property Tax Code further states: "If governing bodies of a majority of the taxing units entitled to vote on the appointment of board members adopt resolutions disapproving a budget and file them with the secretary of the board within 30 days after its adoption, the budget does not take effect, and the board shall adopt a new budget within 30 days of the disapproval."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Fort Worth Independent School District Board of Trustees disapproves of the 2025 Budget of the Tarrant Appraisal District.
