

Nevada County's Holt Ballet Presents The Nutcracker

For nearly 15 years, Nevada County's ballet conservatory, Holt Ballet, and Nevada City's historic cultural center, Miners Foundry, have collaborated to produce Pyotr Ilych Tchaikovsky's, *The Nutcracker*.

This timeless entertainment, a ballet for the whole family, continues to inspire adults and youngsters alike with its wit, beauty, color, and story. For some adults it is their first classical ballet experience, and for many youngsters, it is what compels them to sign up for ballet lessons at their local studio.

Clara and the Nutcracker, a coming of age story as told by Holt Ballet, follows Clara, a 12 year old girl, on the eve of Christmas, who awakens from a dream to find her toys have come to life and are engaging in battle. The toy Uncle Drosselmeyer gave Clara for Christmas, a Nutcracker doll, arrives to save Clara. Defending her from the attacking Mouse King and his threatening rats, the stalwart Nutcracker soldier sacrifices himself to save her.

Restored by Drosselmeyer, the Nutcracker doll becomes a live Prince who escorts Clara in a journey to a whole new world — a world of dancing snowflakes twirling around a snow queen, of exotic maidens snapping their fans to the beat of Spain, of vigorous Cossack soldiers exhibiting their athletic prowess, of an Arabian enchantress hidden behind her scarf, and many other dancing beauties led by the lovely and gracious Sugar Plum Fairy. Clara joins them in dance and adventure on this journey her uncle Drosselmeyer has magicked for her.

Holt Ballet's Clara and the Nutcracker offers a fresh experience with this classical story. Our Clara does not sit on a throne and passively watch life from the distance. She jumps in and participates as a Spanish Fan Dancer, A Rose in the bouquet, A Danish Marzipan playing her reed flute. Performed by Sparrow Stone-Francisco, this 14 year old dancer has skill and artistry beyond her years. Sure footed, a nice actress, and a lovely presence, the audience will never tire of watching her on stage. Our Sugar Plum Fairy, Kaylee Nicholls, 15 years old, will delight our audiences with her strength, control, and musicality. Accompanied by veterans Logan Hollmer, Nutcracker Prince, Christopher Selbie, Cavalier and Snow Prince, and Brooke Colvin, the Snow Queen, this show brings expertise and excellence to the Miners Foundry stage.

Sierra Master Chorale & Orchestra Ring in the Holidays

InConcert Sierra presents the Sierra Master Chorale & Orchestra's "Sing in the Season" holiday concerts, under the direction of Alison Skinner, on Saturday evening, December 20 and Sunday afternoon, December 21.

"This program is inspired by fresh interpretations of classic holiday texts and well-loved tunes," says Skinner, whose artistic vision brings joy and sparkle to the season.

The first half of the program highlights the beauty of Christmas texts in Latin, blending historic works with modern interpretations. "The program starts with an orchestral arrangement of "Adeste Fideles (O Come All Ye Faithful)," followed by choral arrangements of "Personent Hodie" and "Gaudete," both wonderful examples of contemporary composers setting old tunes in new ways, with rhythmic countermelodies and exciting accompaniments," Skinner explains. Audiences will also enjoy Mark Miller's ethereal arrangement of "O Magnum Mysterium," as well as works by Renaissance German composer Heinrich Schütz, whose "Hodie Christus Natus Est" features a recurring dance-like chorus, and Franz Schubert's exuberant


"Magnificat," with a reverent middle movement framed by energetic sections.

The second half of the concert features melodies that are instantly recognizable, including "Carol of the Bells,"" Ding Dong Merrily on High," "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day," "God Rest You Merry Gentlemen," and "The First Nowell." Chanukah favorites, such as "I Had a Little Dreidel, Ma'oz Tzur (Rock of Ages)," and "Jerusalem of Gold," add further variety. Skinner notes, "I love the way these melodies are woven together—familiar carols and tunes with the sparkle of creative composers."

The full program spans centuries and styles, from Renaissance and classical masterpieces to contemporary compositions, offering a rich musical experience for audiences of all ages. Sing-along selections invite the audience to join in, creating a lively and joyful celebration of the season.

The program features beloved seasonal works including Silent Night, We Wish You a Merry Christmas, and O Come All Ye Faithful in




