Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive is May 12

SOUTH COAST - On Saturday May 12, letter carriers will be doing more than just dropping off the mail; they'll also be collecting food for the annual Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive. Hosted by the National Association of Letter Carriers, Stamp Out Hunger takes place around the country and is the largest single-day food drive.

Take part by collecting nonperishable food items and leaving them in a bag near the mailbox early on May 12. A letter carrier or volunteer will pick up the donation

and ensure it gets to Oregon Food Bank. Last year, one million pounds of food was collected in Oregon and Clark County, Wash. This year's goal is 1.2 million. All donated food stays in the community where it was collected.

Face Rock Creamery celebrates five years

BANDON - In 2013, Face Rock Creamery opened with fanfare, with an overflowing crowd of officials, dignitaries and South Coast residents cheering as the ribbon was cut for the company that brought cheese back to Bandon.

Five years later, the creamery is going strong, and the annual anniversary celebration on Mother's Day weekend, the Face Rock Festival, will be bigger and better than ever. The idea is that it's not just about cheese, but about the community coming together to celebrate, organizers said.

This weekend's festivities will run from 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, with live music on a portable stage by Done Deal from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday and 11 a.m.-2 p.m. Sunday. Live music also will be provided by local high school bands from 2-6 p.m. on Sunday, including bands from Marshfield, Siuslaw and Bandon high schools.

In addition, there will be a bouncy house, inflatable obstacle course, face painting

and balloon animals for the kids; tents for a covered seating area; \$3 cheeseburgers (with Face Rock cheese), \$2 hot-dogs, \$2 microbrews, local wine and beer tasting and food sampling, as well as wine, beer, fried cheese curds, ice cream, cheese paninis and other food items for purchase; a dunk tank by the Bandon Aquatic Center; a booth from Bandon Animal Rescue; a demonstration by the BHS Cheer Team; and mimosas on Sunday morning starting at 9 a.m. The event will be broadcast live on The Legend 105.9 FM.

Don't miss an opportunity to see the city of Bandon's newly refurbished trolley that will transport people around town this summer. The trolley was purchased from the city of Jacksonville and is almost ready for use. This weekend it will be on display in the Face Rock Creamery parking lot.
