Bill Bradbury to give 'Big Fish Vision' talk on June 6

BANDON - "Watershed Moments for Salmon" - a free event that is part of the "Big Fish Vision" series of talks and events throughout Bandon - will be presented from 1-2:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 6, at the Bandon Public Library's Sprague Room, 1204 11th St. SW in City Park.

Bandon resident Bill Bradbury presents a fast-moving slide presentation on climate change, the specific effects in Oregon and the global impact. Possible solutions are presented and explored and questions are welcome.

Bradbury served for 14 years in the Oregon Legislature, representing the

southern Oregon coast. From 1999-2009, Bradbury served as Oregon's Secretary of State. His career focused in part on environmental protection and he developed the Salmon and Trout Enhancement Program (STEP). STEP is part of Oregon Fish and Wildlife. Goals include rehabilitating and improving natural habitat and native fish stocks.

Bradbury was one of 50 members of the first Al Gore "An Inconvenient Truth" training team and has given over 500 presentations throughout Oregon.
