CHARLESTON – The public is invited to hear Robert Pitman speak about his research on the ecology and systematics of orcas in Antarctic waters at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 2, at the Oregon Institute of Marine Biology, 63466 Boat Basin Road, Charleston.

His free talk, titled "The family that preys together: Killer whale studies in Antarctic waters" will be held at the OIMB boathouse. Those attending are asked to park at OIMB or along Boat Basin Road and walk past the Coast Guard housing to the OIMB boathouse auditorium.

Robert Pitman is a marine ecologist at the NOAA Southwest Fisheries Science Center in La Jolla, Calif. His research interests include biogeography, foraging ecology, evolutionary biology and general ecology of marine birds, turtles and mammals.



Lots of information is available. The eclipse information, handouts and protective glasses will also be available Aug.15-19 in the library's Logan Room during regular library hours, while supplies last.
