BANDON -- The Bandon Library Art Gallery features "Processing the Image: Manipulated Photographs by Brian York" through Sept. 30.



Cell towers and wifi hazards to be discussed

BANDON — Dr. Martin L. Pall, PhD, renowned retired professor emeritus of biochemistry and medical sciences, Washington State University, will present scientific evidence and medical findings showing how cell towers and Wi-Fi technology are impacting the public's health.

In 2014, the Bandon School District allowed AT&T to install and operate a cell tower on the school campus at the east end of the football field. The school district receives an annual income of \$18,000 from AT&T to lease the space on school property. The cell tower is located approximately 200 feet from Ocean Crest Elementary School. Bandon School District's superintendent, Doug Ardiana, says that he believes that "there is legitimate concern for children who will be in attendance at the school."

Another expert highly regarded for his studies dealing with the health effects of electromagnetic fields, Dr. Samuel Milham, MD, epidemiologist, has documented that people residing up to 500 meters from a cell tower base have increased cancer mortality. Further, Dr. Milham states in an email to Ardiana and John McLaughlin of the City of Bandon Planning Department dated Jan 6, 2017, that, "This technology has no place in schools."


