Cancer Strikes Again - *Brad Sinko*

Our favorite Bandon cheese maker, Brad Sinko, is undergoing cancer treatments. Those of you who know him personally, you know him to be a quiet, humble and an extraordinary human being. Know him personally or not; all know of his legendary cheese making skills. Brad has achieved a national and even international reputation as Face Rock Creamery's Cheese Maker, the master maker who kept the Bandon Cheese dream alive. Brad has been a cheese maker for 31 years and followed in his father, Joe Sinko's, footsteps when he became head cheese maker at the now defunct Bandon Cheese Factory. If you don't know the Bandon Cheese Factory story, ask a local. Bandon hung its hat on the cheese factory. It was as much a part of Bandon as Old Town,

Face Rock and cranberries. When the Bandon Cheese Factory was closed down by new owners, you could taste the sadness and the anger we all felt. And then we shared the joy when Face Rock Creamery came in to replace it – with Brad leading the cheese making operation. You don't see a lot of Brad because he works when we sleep. He kicks off his days at 4 a.m., meeting the milk as it comes in from the local dairy and using old-school, hand cheddaring techniques, he makes cheese so good that it has beaten out – and irritated – the French in international competition. His quest for perfection has brought new fame and admiration to Bandon, and now Brad and his family need our help. They are struggling to navigate this cancer journey. He is not one to ask for help but we are a



community that steps in when we see one of our own is in need. We thought about doing a traditional fundraiser but COVID is making that hard. Instead, we are asking our community to lend a helping hand by making a donation. No party, no auction, no hard sell.

We are just asking that you give if you can, to help the man who has helped make our town a whole lot better.

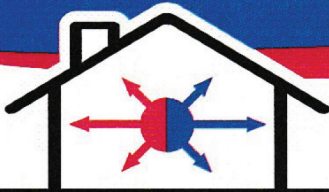

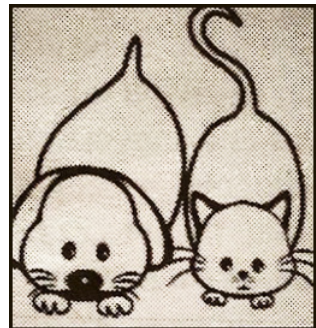
