Bandon recycling center will close June 30

BANDON - China's more restrictive recycling import standards continue to negatively affect recycling efforts here in Oregon. The most recent operational change happened in Douglas County, where all recycling efforts by the Douglas County Landfill and its recycling partner, Sunrise Enterprises, were suspended until further notice, beginning June 1.

In Bandon, the community recycling center will be closing June 30, in favor of curbside recycling available through Bandon Disposal.

Acceptable items to place in your recycle bin:

Plastics in the shape of a jug, tub, or bottle, #1 and # 2 bottleneck only, (no lids, yogurt, butter, cottage cheese, etc. containers.) Paper: clean office paper, newspapers

and magazines (can be printed on, just not soiled). Cardboard: cleaned flattened corrugated boxes (no pizza boxes cereal boxes, egg cartons, etc.) Metal: food and beverage containers, (no lids, empty and rinse all cans, no food or liquid residue.) Glass: all colors - glass bottles and jars, (no lids, rinsed and cleaned.)

All other household waste should be placed in your waste receptacle for disposal.

Curbside recycling is available by calling Bandon Disposal and costs less than \$5 per month. Call 541-347-9633.

Public recycling centers continue to operate North of Bandon at the Coos County Beaver Hill Disposal Site, 55722 Highway 101, and at 1210 S. Broadway in Coos Bay. A \$5 per vehicle disposal charge applies at both locations.
