City to consider Highway 101 ‘road diet’

BANDON – The Bandon Planning Commission will hear a presentation on the possible re-striping of U.S. Highway 101 through the city limits of Bandon during a work session following the regular meeting beginning at 7 p.m. Thursday, Aug 24, in council chamber of City Hall.

The proposed project, also called a “road diet” is being considered in response to several safety concerns, said City Manager Robert Mawson. Representatives of the Oregon Department of Transportation, Mawson and Planning Department staff will be present for the work session.

Public comment will be encouraged, Mawson said.

Specifically, a Highway 101 road diet through the city would reduce the lanes from 13th Street near the 76 gas station to June Avenue, where South Coast Bicycles is located, from five lanes to three lanes, Mawson explained. The center lane would be for turning and the new configuration would

include a bike lane and an area for parking where there is enough space for parking.

Primary among the issues the road diet will address is the safety of pedestrians crossing Highway 101 at Ninth Street, many of which are students on their way to

and from school.

This initial meeting is an informational presentation only, Mawson said. The issue will likely be on the Bandon City Council agenda at its Tuesday, Sept. 4 meeting.
