Shawn Liggett-Torres has known for several years she was going to one day open an antique store. What she didn't know until recently is she would open it in 2020 during the middle of a global pandemic.

Despite the odds stacked against her due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Liggett-Torres recently made her dream come true when she opened Past to Present Emporium next to the historic Tioga Building on North Broadway.

"This was something I always wanted to do, but I

always thought it would be later in life," Liggett-Torres said. "But it was the right time."

After selling antiques and collectibles at Leaf's Treehouse for the last few years, Liggett-Torres said a variety of things made it the right time to open her own business. So earlier this month, she made the plunge.

Inside Past to Present Emporium, guests can see a variety of wares for sale. Ranging from large cabinets, tables and even an 1890 bed to collectibles and dishes, there looks to be something for everyone at prices ranging from \$5 to close to \$1,000.

Liggett-Torres said she got into antiquing because of her personal interest. She said she enjoyed going to yard sales and swap meets and was always looking for something old.

"I like old stuff, especially anything that's feminine," Liggett-Torres said. "Some of my furniture is very feminine."

Like many antique hobbyists, Liggett-Torres said her passion soon grew to an obsession. When her house became too full, she started dabbling in selling. And with each item sold, there was another one to buy. She said she continues to work closely with Leaf's Treehouse and the Old World Antiques. She said working with, rather than against, other businesses in town can benefit them all. "With all of us together,

Bandon-By-The-Sea-Rotary Club's fourth annual Veterans Golf Tournament to benefit Coos County Veterans has been moved to Saturday, Nov. 21, at the Bandon Crossings Golf Course.

The tournament format will be a four-person scramble, but to meet new COVID-19 restrictions, instead of a traditional shotgun start, tee times will be assigned, with the first group starting at 9:30 a.m.

Also, instead of a post-tournament barbecue, the event will feature box lunches that will be placed in the carts.

The entry fee is \$85 per person and includes green fees, range balls, golf cart and the boxed lunch.

Hole-in-one prizes include a \$10,000 cash award sponsored by Bain Insurance and a 2020 Toyota Tundra 4x4 pickup truck sponsored by Coos Bay Toyota. Prizes will be awarded for closes to the pin on all five par-3 holes, as well as for the longest drive for men

and women.

All net proceeds go to veterans organizations serving Coos County.

No handicap is required to enter. The tournament is described as a fun day and great way to honor our veterans.

Needed repairs, upgrades and a new bus barn are in the future for Bandon school facilities after the Bandon School Bond measure passed easily in the election Tuesday.

Bandon voters overwhelmingly approved the measure, 2,783 votes (65.08%) to 1,493 (34.92%).

"We are very happy that the bond passed and are so grateful that our community chose to invest in our schools," Bandon schools superintendent Doug Ardiana said. "This bond will allow us to move ahead with some much needed upgrades to our facilities. We are excited to get to work. We are also so thankful for all of the volunteers who worked so hard to make this bond successful."

Ardiana said the district will be establishing a bond oversight committee that will include school officials and community representatives and that group will oversee our bond expenditures to make sure they fall within the projects

approved by the voters.

Several items were listed as significant projects for the school district.

One will be construction of a new facility for the district's buses.

Another is roof maintenance for all three of the district's schools.

"Our highest priority is going to be our heating and our circulation components of our buildings — to upgrade our air conditioning for the health and safety of our students and staff," Ardiana said.
