BANDON - The American Red Cross has been working hard to find new locations for regular blood drives on the Oregon Coast. Every two seconds, someone in the United States needs a transfusion of blood, and with less than 10 percent of eligible donors actually donating blood currently, there is a crisis-level shortage of blood in the U.S.

That's why when area Red Cross coordinator, Patti McCollum, reached out to Pastor Greg Fodrea at First Baptist Church of Bandon as a potential blood drive host, the small Bandon church opened the doors to its auxiliary building and started spreading the word.

After three relatively successful drives, each larger than the last, First Baptist

Church has now been deemed a successful blood drive partner. The historic church will host Red Cross blood drives every other month, with the next drive happening from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Friday, March 9. Work sessions set at City Hall this week

BANDON - The Bandon City Council and Planning Commission are holding work sessions this week that the public is invited to attend. Public comment is not allowed at work sessions, though written input is permitted. Public comment is always welcome at hearings and regular meetings.

A work session is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 7, with the Planning Commission to hear a presentation by the Bandon Beach Hotel applicants regarding their proposed zoning code amendment. The applicants are proposing to modify the CD-1 zoning text to allow for a building height up to 45 feet, side and rear yards of 5 feet and 55 percent lot

coverage with up to 75 impervious surface. The changes are proposed to only apply to the property currently occupied by the Bandon Beach Motel at 1090 Portland Ave. on Coquille Point.

The Planning Commission will also hold a work session at the same meeting at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 7, to hear a presentation regarding an introduction to a possible new cell tower ordinance for Bandon. An informal discussion will occur with the presentation.

COQUILLE - A grand finale tribute to the memory of painter Anna Crosby and her legacy of artwork will hang March 5-30 at the Coquille Valley Art Center. The Anna Crosby Art Finale open house will be 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, March 10. Honor Crosby for her many years of dedication to the community at her final show.

Crosby started her journey as a member of the Coquille Valley Art Center over 50 years ago. During this time she was on the board of directors, serving as president, vice president, secretary and treasurer many, many times. Some of her instructors included Vicki McKean Smith, Richard McKinley, E. John Robinson, Sally Strand, Albert Handel, Doug Dawson, Billie Sheets, Lora Block, George Walker and Ava Richey.

In 1987 she gave her first pastel workshop at the CVAC and taught classes there for the next 25 years.

Later her classes and workshops branched out to Winston and Canyonville through the Umpqua Community College outreach program and several workshops in Florence. She also served as the superintendent of the art department at the Coos County Fair for over 10 years and was the judge of the Curry County Fair art department in Gold Beach several times.

In 1998 she was named the "Artist in the Garden" at Shore Acres State Park in Coos Bay. The artist won hundreds of ribbons at the Coos County Fair and many at the Pony Village Art Show. She placed 4th in a National Pastel Society of Oregon show.

Showing throughout the county, one of her paintings hung outdoors at the Bandon boardwalk event for three seasons. She has exhibited at Mind Power Gallery in Reedsport, had various installations at Southern Coos Hospital

and Health Center in Bandon, Evergreen Court in North Bend and she even held a private show at the Coquille Community Building.

Crosby's subjects include flowers, landscapes, portraits, abstracts and semi-abstracts, mostly in oils, pastels, acrylics and occasionally in watercolor and pencil.

OCCI hosts high school culinary competition

COOS BAY - Southwestern Oregon Community College's Oregon Coast Culinary Institute will host The Oregon Coast Invitational on April 14. This is a competition for high school students only.

There will be two competitions - culinary and baking. Culinary: Chicken Cordon Bleu, an individual interpretation. Baking: Strawberry Shortcake, an individual interpretation.

The competition begins at 8 a.m. Saturday, April 14, with staggered starting times to allow for students to compete in both competitions if they desire.

Awards to winning individual competitors in the culinary and the baking competitions are: 1st place finishers will receive a \$4,000 scholarship to OCCI; 2nd place finishers will receive a \$3,000 scholarship to OCCI; 3rd place finishers will receive a \$2,000 scholarship to OCCI.

In addition to these scholarship winners, every student participating will receive a \$250 scholarship to attend OCCI.

Your school can be a winner too! The schools represented by the top three winners of each category will be given a cash prize to purchase equipment for the culinary program at their school. The first place winner's school will receive \$300, the second place winner's school will receive \$200, and the third place winner's school will receive \$100.

The entry fees for this year's competition are being paid for by OCCI's chief purveyor, Day Ship Supply. Meals included will be Friday night dinner, a continental breakfast Saturday morning, and an awards banquet luncheon. The awards ceremony and lunch will begin at approximately 12:30 p.m. Saturday. Meals will be provided by Southwestern's catering department.
