Meet & Greet the Artist series begins at Second Street Gallery

BANDON – Pat Cink will be the featured artist for the first of the summer Meet & Greet the Artist series from noon-4 p.m. Saturday, July 8, at the Second Street Gallery, 210 Second St. SE in Old Town Bandon. Cink will be discussing and demonstrating her encaustic techniques in painting seascapes.

Encaustic painting involves painting with a mixture of hot wax, damar resin and pigment on prepared wood. This ancient painting medium was originally developed to waterproof and decorate ships. It was developed into a fine art medium and was most famously used for the Fayum mummy portraits in Egypt around 100-300 AD. The bees wax and damar resin preserved the ancient pig-

ments, so that today those portraits can be viewed in museums in their fresh, rich colors.

Cink likes the medium because the flow of the liquid wax, the layering of translucent colors and sculpturing techniques can create a depth and glow needed in depicting coastal light and ocean waves. Encaustic seems to be a natural progression from her previous use of oil paint, watercolor on Yupo paper and pastels. She is happy when a painting looks realistic, yet is loose enough to see the fun stuff that happened along the way.

The Second Street Gallery is currently displaying a large selection of Cink's "Watery Series" of ocean wave paintings.

Fire season in effect

SOUTH COAST – The Coos Forest Protective Association announced that fire season officially began Monday, June 26. The start of fire season activates restrictions on both public and industrial forest use on all public, private, county, state and Bureau of Land Management lands.

The start of fire season means the end of unregulated outside burning for rural Coos, Curry and western Douglas County. The outside burning of debris piles and the use of burn barrels will be prohibited until fire season is terminated.

Residents living within an incorporated city need to contact their local fire department for burning restrictions and permit details.

The City of Bandon does not allow burning within city limits, including the use of open piles or burn barrels.

Under Oregon law, the use of tracer ammunition and exploding targets is prohib-

ited during fire season, as well as the use of sky lanterns.

Anyone cutting firewood must have an 8 ounce or larger fire extinguisher and a shovel. Power saws must be equipped with an approved spark-arrestor screen.

Industrial fire regulations will also go into effect. Industrial Fire Precaution Level 1 prohibits smoking while working on or traveling through an industrial operation. Specified fire tools and suppression

equipment must be maintained on all operations. A fire watch is also required on all industrial operation sites.

As fire season progresses, additional closures and restrictions may be imposed as weather conditions and fire danger becomes more severe.
