Linke is this week's Meet & Greet the Artist

BANDON – Second Street Gallery welcomes Alex Linke to the gallery this weekend, Saturday, Sept. 9, and Sunday, Sept. 10, for its Meet & Greet Artist series.

Linke will be around most of each day to talk about his ocean-themed "Salt Traffic" mobiles and demonstrate his beautiful finely handcrafted jewelry, "Pieces In Time" using exotic beads with fascinating histories. He combines

naturally formed elements with historic artifacts and treasures. His artful blending of nature and human history creates unique pieces of exceptional beauty, each with its own special story.

"In choosing components for my jewelry, I look for pieces with an intriguing past, whether a fossil, stone, bead or artifact," said Linke. "Each piece has its own story, and when you

string all of these bits and pieces of past worlds and lives together, you have a living history."

After moving with his family from Bavaria, Germany, to Malibu, Calif., Linke worked as a commercial fisherman, yacht skipper and tugboat captain, then served as director of the Port of Bandon for 30 years. His mobiles have been sold to collectors across the United States.
