Every two seconds, someone in the United States needs a transfusion of blood, and with less than 10 percent of eligible donors actually donating blood currently, there is a crisis-level shortage of blood in the U.S.

That's why when area Red Cross coordinator, Patti McCollum, reached out to Pastor Greg Fodrea at First Baptist Church of Bandon as a potential blood drive host, the small Bandon church opened the doors to its auxiliary building and started spreading the word.

After three relatively successful drives, each larger than the last, First Baptist Church has

now been deemed a successful blood drive partner. The historic church will host Red Cross blood drives every other month, with the next drive happening from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Friday, March 9.
