

Yoga Hive reopens with extra safety measures

BANDON — The Yoga Hive is Bandon is now open for classes again with additional safety measures put in place, according to co-owner Debi Ellis.

After months of getting the Yoga Hive ready to open, in September 2019 the facility opened to an enthusiastic welcome from the community of Bandon.

Flash forward a few months, COVID-19 arrived in the United States and Ellis made the decision to close the Yoga Hive's doors for the time being.

"Cause and transmission were not clear and no one wanted to risk other's lives finding out," Ellis said. "As a society, we

were asked to go inward. Figuratively first by restricting our traveling and associations with others. The harder task was going inward personally. It is a test of skills for those practicing yoga."

The "Aha" moment came for many of the instructors and students when they were forced to examine more deeply what yoga meant to them aside from the asana (the physical practice of yoga poses or postures).

Luckily for those practicing yoga, the desire to stay connected had overridden their anxiety and Zoom classes began to flourish everywhere.

"We jumped on the bandwagon in an effort to

stay connected to our students and began offering online classes," Ellis said. "This has proven to be a remarkable, unexpected way to stay connected, especially for those students who were considered high risk and could not leave the house. I have been told the classes were a lifeline."

As challenging as it has been for Ellis to juggle her position and teach yoga on Zoom, she said it has nourished her and given her the ability to continue to do her job in the spirit it deserves.

"I was recently told by a student that when COVID hit, she didn't know how she would survive, but with yoga she has realized she is actually thriving.
