Southwestern offers transitional education classes winter term

COOS BAY - The Transitional Education Department, a college and career preparation program at Southwestern Oregon Community College, will offer General Education Development (GED) exam preparation, college and career preparation, college placement test preparation, Adult Basic Education (ABE), and English Language Acquisition (ELA) courses winter term. Brush pick-up to begin Jan. 8

BANDON - The first brush and yard debris removal event of 2018 will start on Monday, Jan. 8. Bandon Disposal will be picking up piles of brush and yard debris. City residents are allowed up to a maximum of 5 cubic yards of brush and yard debris (approximately two pickup loads) at no cost. Simply place brush and yard debris in the right-of-way alongside the street adjacent to your house prior to Monday, Oct. 9 and Bandon Disposal will pick it up.

Note: It may take several weeks for Bandon Disposal to pick up all the debris and brush piles around town, so residents are asked to be patient. If, after several week, your brush and debris pile has not been picked up, contact Bandon Disposal at 541-347-9633 and let them know.

Make sure that the brush is in one pile, since there is a maximum of one pile per address, and no group piles. Keep in mind that this program is for woody yard debris such as branches, brush, gorse, etc., so

other items and materials such as metals, appliances, furniture, etc. will not be accepted.

Branches must be cut into lengths no longer than 5 feet. Grass clippings and leaves will also be picked up, provided they are placed in biodegradable paper bags.

No plastic bags can be accepted. Also, please avoid placing your pile under overhead utility lines or overhanging trees, since a boom truck is used to pick up the debris. Locate your pile away from fire hydrants and utility boxes, and do not impede sidewalks or pedestrian walkways.

A total of three brush and yard debris removal events are held each year. This is the first event for 2018. The others are scheduled for June and October. Those who have more than 5 cubic yards of debris, or who want debris picked up at times other than the three brush removal weeks, can contact Bandon Disposal at 541-347-9633 for a price quote.

Photos, wood sculptures on display at library

BANDON - The Bandon Library Art Gallery features “Melancholia” - photographs by Manuela Durson, along with wood sculptures by Dan Sawyer. The exhibits will be on display through Jan. 31.

The minimalist photographs of Durson contain a spare but vibrant beauty. These strong, uncluttered images are imbued with a melancholic spirit, but not a negative one. On the contrary, they evoke the silent, profound experience of being alone with nature in a depopulated world. The traces of humanity she does make note of, the decrepit “Lone Dory” and the rotted remains of a pier in “Into the Blue” only

emphasize the contemplative solitude of the moment. These photographs were taken all along the West Coast, from Mexico to Oregon.

Sawyer gathers driftwood from Bandon and other beaches, and transforms it into free-form sculpture. He emphasizes the wood’s innate characteristics through sanding and polishing and may cut into the original piece to find its sculptural essence. With their curved lines and rounded surfaces, these sculptures flow like the sea that cast them up.
