Bay Area Concert Band kicks off season Oct. 26

NORTH BEND - The Bay Area Concert Band will open its 2017-2018 season on Thursday, Oct. 26, with a concert starting at 7:30 p.m. at the North Bend Presbyterian Church on Pony Creek Road. Conductor, Steve Simpkins, has selected a very eclectic program that will feature music from the classical to the hilarious.

The Sorcerer’s Apprentice by Paul Dukas, written in 1897, is the featured classical work. It was the only composition by Dukas that ever achieved any popularity and true distinction. If you have seen the Walt Disney animated film, Fantasia, you might relate it to Mickey Mouse’s role. The opening of the piece takes place in the sorcerer’s workshop where the apprentice discovers enough of his master’s magic to bring a broom to life. The broom performs the apprentice’s chore, that of bringing water, but alas, the apprentice does not know the magic for making it stop. Bedlam results. The sorcerer returns, speaks the magic words and calm is restored. Four quick chords at the end may

suggest the number of whacks delivered to the mischievous apprentice.

The hilarious is A Salute to Spike Jones, arranged by Calvin Custer. The songs included are, Cocktails for Two, Chloe, and the Poet and Peasant Overture. Spike Jones was a studio drummer in Los Angeles who began adding unusual sound effects to his performances, using items like car horns, cowbells, doorbells and kitchen utensils. He formed his own group called Spike Jones and The City Slickers and recorded hit songs utilizing comical voice effects, the sounds of live goats, barking dogs and instruments from slide whistles to “latrinophones,” a toilet with strings and played like a harp.

The remainder of the program will be rounded out with The Sound of Music by Rodgers and Hammerstein and Military Symphony in F by Francois Joseph Gossec, and a march or two.

This is a free concert with donations appreciated and used for scholarships for our young musicians.

Chinese brush paintings on display at library

BANDON - Chinese brush paintings by local artist Janice Horne will be on display through Nov. 30 at the Bandon Library Art Gallery.

The subtle colors, delicate lines and spare composition of Chinese brush painting are very different from art made in the West. While traveling in China 30 years ago, Horne studied and practiced this ancient art, a discipline passed down through the generations by masters to new students.

Using their chi (one's own, intrinsic energy or life force) to guide them, students work to replicate the brush, composition

and color techniques of the masters, until they are ready to create their own works, at which point they use these difficult and precise methods in original compositions.

Artistic satisfaction is derived from both the successful grasping and executing of the masters' work and from the ability to find one's own personal expression via the medium.

In this show, Horne displays both paintings that represent the work of the masters of the Lingman School of Art (of the Guangdong region), as well as her own, original paintings.
