Fisher "the best prose writer in America" and John Updike referred to her as "Poet of the Appetites."

The cast includes Corrie Gant as M.F.K. Fisher, along with Neal Davis, Jackie Lawrence, Amy Moss Strong and Richard Robinett. Director is Donald Zealand, long-time Fisher fan and her bibliographer.
