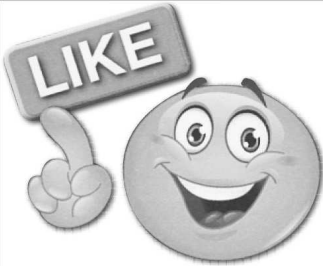

Striders off Blacklock Point hike

PORT ORFORD -- Hike with the South Coast Striders to Blacklock Point from Floras Lake on Sunday July 23.

There will be long and short options for this hike.

Long Hike: Join Reg Pullen for this rugged 8.5 mile journey from Floras Lake to Blacklock Point along beaches, densely wooded trails and exposed rocky points with beautiful ocean views.
