

Striders off Blacklock Point hike

PORT ORFORD -- Hike with the South Coast Striders to Blacklock Point from Floras Lake on Sunday July 23.

There will be long and short options for this hike.

Long Hike: Join Reg Pullen for this rugged 8.5 mile journey from Floras Lake to Blacklock Point along beaches, densely wooded trails and exposed rocky points with beautiful ocean views. This is a beautiful hike with plenty of history and local lore in the mix. It is rated difficult to most difficult, with some mild bushwhacking.

Dress in layers; a windbreaker with a hood is highly recommended. Bring water and something to eat during a stop at the point.
