"Well, if you don't know, gorse is a nasty invasive seen throughout our area that is highly flammable, painful to the touch and nearly impossible to remove," Schubothe said. "We don't like it. We would even say we hate it. But, it's here, it's part of our heritage and we often get visitors who know nothing about it."

Luckily, Bandon has some resources for dealing with this plant, including the Gorse Action Group. Representatives of GAG will be at the festival, along with others providing some not-so-fun facts about the plant, education about what it is and what to do with it, and, most importantly, how everyone can help stop it from spreading.
