COQUILLE - A grand finale tribute to the memory of painter Anna Crosby and her legacy of artwork will hang March 5-30 at the Coquille Valley Art Center. The Anna Crosby Art Finale open house will be 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, March 10. Honor Crosby for her many years of dedication to the community at her final show.

Crosby started her journey as a member of the Coquille Valley Art Center over 50 years ago. During this time she was on the board of directors, serving as president, vice president, secretary and treasurer many, many times.
