Notice is hereby given that a public hearing regarding a proposed increase to the Bandon Disposal and Recycling garbage collection and disposal rates will be held before the Bandon City Council on **Tuesday, October 2, 2018, at 7:00 PM**, in the City Council Chambers, 555 Highway 101, Bandon, Oregon. The requested increase is for a 3.15% consumer price index adjustment, which would result in an increase of \$0.57 per month for a basic 35-gallon residential cart service, and an increase of \$0.73 per yard for commercial container service. Other rates would be adjusted proportionally. 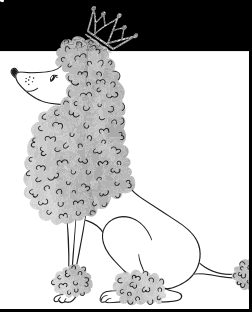

Only household hazardous waste will be accepted.

The collection event allows Coos and Curry county residents to safely dispose of a wide range of materials including pesticides, solvents, fluorescent lights, pool chemicals,

aerosol cans, caustic cleaners, mercury thermometers and flammable liquids. Ammunition, asbestos, explosives, fireworks, radioactive materials and medical wastes will not be accepted.

The county requests that all disposable materials be in their original containers or otherwise properly labeled.

No large quantities of "unknowns" will be accepted.

Remembering the 1936 Bandon Fire

BANDON – The Bandon Historical Society will commemorate the 82nd anniversary of the 1936 Bandon Fire with a program at the museum Sunday, Sept. 23. The museum will open at noon for the free event, courtesy of the Bandon Inn. The program will begin at 2 p.m.

Bandon mayor and historical society volunteer Mary Schamehorn will moderate the museum's Fire program.

"We've told this story many times, but always learn something new to share," said museum board president Jim Proehl. "The program is fashioned to be of interest both to those who are learning about the fire for the first time and those who are steeped in the story."
