# Spring is the time to clean up, so burn responsibly

SOUTH COAST - Now is the time to start removing brush and debris from around homes, and rainy spring days are the best time to get the backyard burning accomplished. Residents are asked to burn responsibly, as debris burning is one of the leading causes of wildfires in southwest Oregon. The Coos Forest Protective Association encourages residents to get burning projects completed as early as possible this spring. This

takes advantage of wet fuel conditions, which helps prevent debris burns from escaping.

Common reasons debris burns escape control include:

- burning in high winds
- not having an adequate clearing around the pile
- leaving a debris burn unattended or ensuring it is completely extinguished
- burning too late into the spring
- burning too large of a pile

■ For machine built piles please call CFPA for advice Always keep in mind that anytime individuals are responsible for maintaining control of their burn. For burning restrictions inside the city limits contact your local fire department. For example, burning is not allowed in Bandon city limits. # Coast Guard Auxiliary offers free vessel safety checks

SOUTH COAST - The U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 51 Coos Bay members offer to the boating public a free boat safety inspection. The USCG trained examiners will certify the boat if it meets Oregon and federal U.S. Coast Guard boating laws for equipment

and will issue a current decal certifying compliance. The examiners will also make recommendations to boat owners for operation in local waters.

# **Spring safety reminders for the Oregon Coast**

OREGON COAST - The arrival of spring brings many visitors to the Oregon coast and the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department wants people to be safe while exploring the shoreline.

Coastal threats can come in the form of powerful waves, unstable logs on beaches and erosion of rocks and cliffs.

"People are so excited for the spring sunshine that sometimes safety takes a back seat," said Lisa Stevenson, OPRD beach ranger speaking at Cape Kiwanda State Natural Area. "But preparation and common sense go a long way to keeping you safe on the coast."

Stevenson listed several tips for ensuring your trip to the coast is a safe one:

Always keep one eye on the ocean so you won't be caught off guard if a bigger wave surges up the beach. These "sneaker waves" are unpredictable, power-

ful and especially dangerous for children.

- Stay away from logs on the wet sand or in the surf. These logs can weigh several tons and can be moved by only a few inches of water. The ocean is strong enough to pick up even the biggest log and roll it over you.
- Know when the tide is coming in, especially when exploring tidepools. It's easy to become stranded by the incoming tide when your attention is elsewhere. You can keep track of tides with a tide table; OPRD park rangers and many local businesses can give you one for free.
- Be careful on cliffs and rocks. They can be unstable due to erosion. Stay on marked trails and do not climb over fences. Both are there to keep you safe.
