The 2016-2017 school year has seen some amazing accomplishments for North Bend High School. This past Fall, our football team accomplished what no other team in our 110 year history had been able to achieve by having an undefeated season, capping off the year

by winning it's first OSAA State Championship. During the last four years, our senior class has been to the semi-finals twice and played for two state titles. This year's class also has the claim to having the only boy to ever win a State Title in Boy's Cross Country. This past Spring, our band continued it's impressive string of accomplishment by winning a fourth straight state title. This year's senior class band members have never known anything but victory at the OSAA State Championships, an accomplishment that no other team at North Bend High School, and very few others around the state have ever accomplished. This year, North Bend High School won eight Far West League Titles.
