See seashells at free OIMB talk

CHARLESTON - Nearly everyone picks up seashells on the shore, but most don't really understand what they are and how they live in the underwater world.

The public is invited to an illustrated presentation at 7 p.m. Friday, May 11, that addresses such questions, presented by Professor Geerat Vermeij, one of the world's foremost authorities on living and fossil shells. The title of his lecture will be: "Shells: an ecological and historical window on the marine world."

Immediately following the lecture, interested individuals will be admitted to the Charleston Marine Life Center, where Dr. Vermeij, who is totally blind, will explore the museum's shell collections with his hands and explain the form, lifestyles and evolutionary history of the specimens he finds there.

This is a truly rare opportunity for anyone who collects shells or has an interest in marine life.

The talk will be held in the OIMB Boathouse Auditorium in Charleston (Park near OIMB and walk to the end of Boat Basin Drive, past the Coast Guard housing complex). Admission is free and all are invited.

Dr. Geerat Vermeij is currently a professor of earth sciences at the University of California, Davis. He was born in the Netherlands and lost his sight at the age of three. Despite this challenge, he has become one of the premier evolutionary biologists of our time.

Five years later, the creamery is going strong, and the annual anniversary celebration on Mother's Day weekend, this year named the Face Rock Festival, will be bigger and better than ever. The idea is that it's not just about cheese, but about the community coming together to celebrate, organizers said.

This weekend's festivities will run from 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Saturday, May 12, and 11 a.m.-6 p.m. Sunday, May 13, with live music on a portable stage by Done Deal from 11 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday and 11 a.m.-2 p.m. Sunday. Live music also will be

provided by local high school bands from 2-6 p.m. on Sunday, including bands from Marshfield, Siuslaw and Bandon high schools.

In addition, there will be a bounce house, obstacle course and face painting for the kids, supervised by the BHS Cheer Team; tents for a covered seating area; \$3 cheeseburgers (with Face Rock cheese), \$2 hotdogs and \$2 microbrews as well as wine, beer, cheese and food sampling; a dunk tank by the Bandon Aquatic Center and a booth from Bandon Animal Rescue; and mimosas on Sunday morning starting at 9 a.m. The event will be broadcast live on The Legend 105.9 FM.
