## 'Spring Fling' event to benefit Aquatic Center

BANDON - The Spring Fling Dinner and Silent Auction to benefit the Bandon Aquatic Center will be held on Saturday, April 14, at the Bandon Community Center-The Barn, 1200 11th St. SW.

The event will feature a four-course meal (for vegetarians and non-vegetarians), served by enthusiastic pool supporters. Doug Adriana, Bandon Schools Superintendent, will be master of ceremonies for the event and entertainment will be provided by the Bandon High School Speech Team. Doors open at 5:30 p.m. and dinner will be served at 6:30 p.m.

Tickets may be purchased with cash or check in Bandon at Ace Hardware and The Cobbler's Bench; in Coquille at The Coffee Connection; in Port Orford at The Crazy Norwegian; and from Bandon Aquatic Center Board members. The cost is \$35 per person; a table for 8 people is \$250.

Before the dinner, information will be available about the Bandon Aquatic Center's location, activities, construction and operational costs and membership plans. The Aquatic Center's feasibility study will also be available. The study details projected incomes and revenues, population projections of the service area

and tourism contributions. Also available will be a list of successful privately operated, publicly available swimming pools and aquatic centers in Oregon.

"Pools Save Lives" is the motto of USA Swimming, a national program providing resources for aquatic centers. Their programs are based on four pillars: rehabilitation, learn to swim, competition, and fitness. The Bandon Aquatic Center strongly identifies with all four pillars. A therapy pool will facilitate recovery from sports injuries and bone surgeries, and there will be an equipped fitness/exercise room.

Once the pool is built, a Red Cross-certified instructor will conduct swimming classes for people of all ages. The three high schools in Bandon, Coquille and Langlois-Port Orford are expected to sponsor swim teams in the competition-sized pool.

Those who have met the Bandon schools superintendent or attended events presented by the BHS Speech Team know it will be a fun evening.
